PART C: SHARING IN GOD'S GLORY THROUGH JESUS

What is the glory that the Father gave to Jesus?

John 1:14 And the Word became flesh ... we saw His **glory, glory** as of the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth.

II Peter 1:17 For when He received honor and **glory** from God the Father, such an utterance as this was made to Him by the Majestic **Glory**, "This is My beloved Son with whom I am well-pleased "

How does Jesus give that glory to us?

John 1:12 But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God.

Romans 8:17, 19, 21 We are children of God, and if children, heirs also, heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ ... waiting eagerly for the revealing of the sons of God ... set free into the freedom of the **glory** of the children of God.

Hebrews 2:10 Bringing many sons to **glory**.

I John 3:2 We are children of God ... we know that when he appears, we shall be like him, for we shall see him as he is.

Hebrews 2:11 He is not ashamed to call them brethren.

Conclusion: God promises to give us Himself (to let us share in His glory). He gives us Himself by giving us His Son, and (through His Son) welcoming us as His sons.

#4 in His glory

Genesis 1:27 God created man in His own image

Psalms 8:3-8

Romans 3:23 All have sinned and fall short of the **glory** of God

I Peter 1:24 All flesh is like grass, and all its **glory** is like the flower of grass. The grass withers, and the flower falls off...

II Thes. 1:9 These will pay the penalty of eternal destruction, away from presence of the Lord and from the **glory**...

John 17:22 the **glory** which You have given Me I have given to them

I Peter 5:1 a partaker also of the **glory** that is to be revealed

I Peter 4:13-14 If you are reviled for the name of Christ, you are blessed, because the Spirit of **glory** and of God rests on you.

II Peter 1:3-4 seeing that His divine power has granted to us everything pertaining to life and godliness, through the true knowledge of Him who called us by His own **glory** and excellence. For by these He has granted to us His precious and magnificent promises, so that by them you may become partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world by lust.

II Cor. 3:18 But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the **glory** of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from **glory** to **glory**, just as from the Lord, the Spirit.

Romans 9:23-24a to make known the riches of His **glory** upon vessels of mercy ... prepared beforehand for **glory**, even us.

I Thes. 2:12 walk in a manner worthy of the God who calls you into His own kingdom and **glory**.

Hebrews 2:10 bringing many sons to **glory**

I Timothy 2:10 I endure all things for the sake of those who are chosen, so that they also may obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus and with it eternal **glory**.

I Peter 5:10 God called you to His eternal **glory** in Christ.

II Thes. 2:14 It was for this He called you through our gospel, that you may gain the **glory** of our Lord Jesus Christ.

I John 3:2 Beloved, now we are children of God, and it has not appeared as yet what we will be. We know that when He appears, we will be like Him, because we will see Him just as He is.

II Cor. 4:17 For momentary, light affliction is producing for us an eternal weight of **glory** far beyond all comparison

Eph. 1:18 the riches of the **glory** of His inheritance in the saints

Phil. 3:21 who will transform the body of our humble state into conformity with the body of His **glory**

I Cor. 15:42-43 It is sown a perishable body, it is raised an imperishable body; it is sown in dishonor, it is raised in **glory**.

I Peter 1:7 the proof of your faith ... may be found to result in praise and **glory** and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ

I Cor. 2:7 we speak ... the hidden wisdom which God predestined before the ages to our **glory**.

Eph. 5:27 Christ gave Himself up ... that He might present to Himself the church in all her **glory**.
