In an emergency briefing, the Russian Ministry of Defense announced that it has placed the Radiological, Chemical and Biological Protection (RCBZ) forces on red alert as either the explosion of a "dirty nuclear bomb" or the firing of a tactical nuclear weapon in Ukraine is imminent.

From the information released by the Russian Ministry of Defense, and unfortunately confirmed 100% by WarNews247, it appears that Moscow is leaning towards the use of a tactical nuclear weapon as it states that radioactive substances will cover Poland and also spread in the atmosphere up to 1,500 kilometers.

RUSSIA: "WE ARE IN THE FINAL STAGE"

Russia said today that Ukraine has entered the "final stage" of building a "dirty bomb". It is Moscow's second warning since yesterday, Sunday, but which Kyiv and its Western allies reject.

"According to the information we have, two Ukrainian organizations have specific instructions to build the so-called 'dirty bomb.' Their work has entered the final stage, " Major General Igor Kirillov, the Russian military's head of radioactive substances, biological and chemical products, said in a statement.

As he said, "the purpose of this provocation is to accuse Russia of using weapons of mass destruction in Ukraine and thus launch a strong anti-Russian campaign in the world", he said, estimating that Kiev mainly wants to "intimidate the local population and increase the flow of refugees across Europe".

Kirillov referred to Zelensky's speech in Munich last February, when he said he expressed his intention to restore Ukraine's nuclear regime.

"It is also noteworthy that during the special military operation Zelensky repeatedly called on NATO countries to carry out strikes on Russia," Kirillov said, recalling that on October 22, in an interview with Canadian television channels, Zelensky urged the world to hit the Kremlin if Russia hits the Ukrainian president's office.

Red Alert for Radiation, Chemical and Biological Protection forces!

The Russian military has reportedly put its forces on high alert to carry out operations in radioactively contaminated conditions due to the possibility of Ukraine using a "dirty bomb".

"The Ministry of Defense of the Russian Federation has information that the Kiev regime is planning a provocation related to the detonation of a so-called 'dirty bomb' or a low-yield nuclear weapon," said Igor Kirillov, head of the Russian Army's RCBZ forces.

"The Ministry of Defense has put the forces on high alert to deal with possible challenges from Ukraine, the forces and means are ready to perform tasks in conditions of radioactive contamination," said Igor Kirillov, head of the Russian Radiological, Chemical and Biological Protection Troops. (RCBZ).

"The explosion of a radiological explosive device will inevitably lead to radioactive contamination of the area up to several thousand square meters," he said.

"According to the information we have, two Ukrainian organizations have specific instructions to create the so-called 'dirty bomb.'

"In addition, we have information about the contacts of the office of the President of Ukraine with representatives of Great Britain on the issue of the possible acquisition of technology for the creation of nuclear weapons. For this, Ukraine has an appropriate production base and scientific potential," said Kirillov.

According to him, "there are nuclear industry enterprises in Ukraine that have stocks of radioactive substances that can be used to create a "dirty bomb" - these are three nuclear plants that are still operating:

South-Ukrainian, Khmelnitsky and Rivne with nine tanks of nuclear fuel. They contain up to 1.5 thousand tons of uranium oxide enriched to 1.5%.

"At the decommissioned Chernobyl nuclear power plant with radioactive waste storage facilities, 22,000 spent fuel assemblies containing uranium-238 are stored, as well as products related to the operation - uranium-235 and plutonium-239, which are the main component of a nuclear charge said Kirillov.

"At the radioactive waste processing enterprise" Vector", at the Pridneprovsky chemical plant, at the Buryakovka, Podlesny, Rossokha radioactive waste disposal sites, more than 50 thousand cubic meters of radioactive waste can be accommodated, which can also be used as components for a "dirty bomb".

The Vostochny mining and processing plant mines uranium ore in two of the three mines with a capacity of up to 1,000 tons per year," said the head of the RKhBZ troops.

"There is a scientific base in Ukraine - this is the Kharkiv Institute of Physics and Technology, whose scientists participated in the USSR's nuclear program, where various experimental facilities are currently operating, including the Uragan thermonuclear facilities, as well as the Institute for Nuclear Research at the National Academy of Sciences in Kyiv, where research is being conducted at the WWR-M reactor using high-level radioactive materials," he concluded.

RUSSIAN SVR: THEY WANT NUKES!

"I find the Western rhetoric about the possibility of using nuclear weapons extremely disturbing.

It is impermissible," said Sergei Naruskin, head of the Foreign Intelligence Service (SVR), arguing that the world should not allow Kiev to acquire nuclear weapons.

"That the current regime in Kiev wishes to have nuclear weapons, humanity has been able to see it on many occasions, starting from the day when the president of Ukraine, V. Zelensky, spoke at a security conference in Munich.

His ambitions to possess nuclear weapons were clear even then.

The world must not allow this to happen," stressed Narushkin, who, when asked if Russian rhetoric "would leave room for a possibility of using nuclear weapons," answered categorically in the negative.

Russian Duma: Zelensky a nuclear terrorist!

The president of the Russian Duma, Vyacheslav Volodin, who accuses the West of being an accomplice of the Kiev regime, accuses the Ukrainian president, V. Zelensky, of methods of nuclear terrorism, like those used by Osama bin Laden's al Qaeda.

"The methods of nuclear terrorism have not changed.

The ones used by Osama bin Laden are now being used by Zelensky.

The US president and European leaders, by providing financial and military aid to Zelensky's regime, become sponsors and accomplices of nuclear terrorism," Volodin said in a post on Telegram.

According to Volodin, about 20 years ago the US claimed that "Al Qaeda terrorists under Osama bin Laden had gained access to radioactive substances" and that they were "planning to create a 'dirty' bomb capable of contaminating a large area with radioactivity".

"The threat of a terrorist attack on the US and Europe using such a bomb existed until 2011, when Osama bin Laden was killed," points out Volodin, who attacks Kiev.

"Kiev regime ordered nuclear scientists to build a 'dirty' bomb.

They continue to bomb critical nuclear power plant infrastructure – in Zaporozhia and Kursk – thus causing a humanitarian disaster," Volodin underlined.

WHAT DID PESKOV SAY?

Peskov also made special reference to the complaints made by Russia regarding the "dirty" bomb that Kyiv accuses of having in its hands.

"The disbelief of some Western states in the information transmitted by the Russian side about the existence of a "dirty" bomb does not mean that the threat of using such a bomb ceases to exist.

The threat is obvious," Peskov argued, noting that this information was brought to the attention of several foreign defense ministers by Russian Defense Minister S. Soigu.

"It is up to them to believe or not to believe," underlined the Kremlin representative.

WHAT ARE "DIRTY" NUCLEAR BOMBS?

According to the Russians, the technologies available to the Ukrainian military do not allow for the creation of tactical nuclear weapons. Therefore, we are talking about the so-called dirty atomic bomb.

The use of such ammunition will not give an instant result, but will make the area uninhabitable for several decades.

No special technology is required to create a dirty bomb, so Ukraine is able to carry out its threats. In the simplest version, they can simply fill any explosive device with radioactive debris.

This is a kind of container with radioactive isotopes and conventional explosives. The explosion destroys the container and transports the substances over a large area with a shock wave. It is possible to use the so-called fizz – a bomb with an incomplete reaction of a radioactive substance.

In the third option, a full charge is stored directly on the earth's surface in order to maximize soil contamination with radiation.

An example of a "dirty" bomb, however, that exploded unintentionally, can be considered the accident at the Chernobyl nuclear power plant.

Kherson became a graveyard of tanks & armored personnel carriers

Kherson has turned into a vast graveyard of tanks and armored personnel carriers with the videos that have been released showing the extent of the losses of the Ukrainian Army.

Russian paratroopers destroyed a battalion of the 28th Brigade of the Armed Forces of Ukraine during an unsuccessful attack on Kherson.

The mechanized battalion of the 28th Special Brigade of the Armed Forces of Ukraine was equipped with Skopje and Slovenian tanks.

Russian Paratroopers wiped out Kherson's 1st Berislav Motorized Battalion. The frames of the video show destroyed T-72 tanks,- T-64BV, MT-LB APCs, armored BRDMs, Humvees and BMP APCs.

In fact, in the last video, the Ukrainians seem to have abandoned their wounded on the battlefield. Russian UAV locates injured Ukrainian. He is later captured by the Russians.

According to Russian media, "as a result of an unsuccessful attack in the Berislav direction, the Ukrainian army lost an almost complete mechanized battalion, equipped with tanks that were previously delivered by Skopje and Slovenia. The corresponding video was published by the RIA Novosti news agency.

. . . At the same time, the Russian authorities in Kherson today called on the civilians to leave the city immediately, due to the escalation of the war situation.

Thousands of civilians have been fleeing the city for days by crossing the Dnipro River, following reports of an imminent counterattack by the Ukrainians, with the objective of recapturing the city, while today's message was urgently disseminated.

What is surprising – and worrying – is the urgency of the evacuation signal in Kherson.

Most likely this is related to possible information about blowing up the dam at the Kakhovka hydroelectric plant in the Kherson region . . .

Long-hour battle of the Russian artillery

Kherson has turned into a graveyard of NATO equipment with the Ukrainian forces counting over 320 dead and dozens of tanks and armored vehicles destroyed.

They swept Central, Western and Eastern Ukraine

Central, western and eastern Ukraine are receiving a simultaneous massive cruise missile attack from warships and strategic bombers with the Russians taking off nine Tu-160s and Tu-95s capable of launching up to 108 missiles.

The Russians hit mainly the Ukrainian regions of Lviv, Lutsk and Kovel, which border Poland with upgraded cruise missiles. This fact may be an indication of preparations for a ground attack by Belarus.

Perhaps this is the largest operation of the Russians so far in the Ukrainian war. Air raid sirens are sounding across Ukraine as missiles hit the country's critical infrastructure.

According to Russian media, nine strategic bombers capable of carrying 108 cruise missiles took off simultaneously to strike Ukrainian targets.

Each of them can carry 12 cruise missiles of various types, a total of 108 missiles.

"Ukrainian sources report the launch of X-101 missiles from a Tu-160 bomber. There are reportedly nine (!) such aircraft in the air now," Russian sources say.

During the massive cruise missile strikes against Ukraine today, an unusual tactic was used.

According to Ukrainian sources, during the shelling in the western part of the country, the Russian cruise missiles abruptly changed their trajectory, avoiding the air defense of the Armed Forces of Ukraine and launching strikes in Vinnitsa and Lutsk.

According to the information, some of the missiles changed their trajectory and instead of flying over the Khmelnitsky and Ternopil regions, they headed towards the Ivano-Frankivsk region, accurately hitting targets in the Lutsk region.

The Ukrainians have deployed air defense systems in these areas to protect arms supply routes from the West.

For the first time in almost 80 years, the US has moved and deployed to Europe the elite 101st Airborne Division "Screaming Eagles", consisting of 4,700 soldiers.

It is the first deployment of this elite segment in Europe since 1945.

4,700 American soldiers of the 101st Airborne Division (the legendary Screaming Eagles) have arrived in Eastern Romania, just 300 km from Nikolaev and Kherson, US media reports.

The 101st Airborne Division deployed to Europe for the first time in nearly 80 years amid rising tensions between Russia and the US-led NATO military alliance. This unit, nicknamed the 'Screaming Eagles', can be deployed and fighting on any battlefield in the world within hours.

CBS News interviewed the Division's deputy commander, Brigadier General John Lubas, and Col. Edwin Matthaidess, 2nd Brigade Combat Team Commander.

They flew in a Black Hawk helicopter for an hour-long ride just three miles from Romania's border with Ukraine.

The American CBS correspondent reports:

"Since Russian President Vladimir Putin launched his full-scale invasion of Ukraine on February 24, his forces have advanced north from the Crimean peninsula, a Ukrainian region that Moscow illegally seized control of in 2014. For more than seven months, Russian troops have attempted to advance along the Black Sea coast in the Kherson region, aiming to capture the key Ukrainian ports of Nikolaev and Odessa.

Their goal is to cut off all access of Ukraine to the sea, creating a landlocked country.

This threat is so close to NATO territory in Romania that is why one of America's most elite divisions, with heavy equipment, has been sent.

US 101st Division ready for engagement

The US Army's 101st Airborne Division is ready to enter Ukraine in the event of further tensions between Russia and Ukraine or an attack on a NATO member state, CBS News reported, citing the Division's command.

"We are ready to defend every centimeter of NATO territory," said the division's deputy commander.

The commander of the 2nd Brigade Combat Team, Col. Edwin Matthaidess, in turn noted that his troops, deployed in Romania, are "closely monitoring" Russian forces, "building targets to practice on" and conducting exercises that "replicate exactly this which happens "in war.

"In all, about 4,700 troops from the US 101st Airborne base in Kentucky have been deployed to bolster NATO's eastern flank," CBS News noted.

Heading north along Romania's Black Sea coast, the Black Hawk found itself in an exercise where US and Romanian troops were striking targets during a joint ground and air assault.

The tank shots and artillery fire were real. The exercise was meant to recreate the daily battles Ukrainian forces wage against Russian troops, just across the border.


War games so close to these borders are a clear signal to Russia and America's NATO allies that the US military is here.

Shocking news comes from Russia as shelters have been ordered to be prepared in the Russian capital, something that even goes beyond the Cold War. They have already started putting up signs and moving hospital operating rooms into bomb shelters.

The Russian leadership is preparing for the worst scenario: For the third day, the blowing up of the dam of the Kakhovskaya hydroelectric power station is high on the Russian media.

If this happens, there is a serious possibility of either direct or indirect nuclear disaster as the cooling system of the NPP Zaporizhzhya nuclear power plant will be seriously threatened.

We remind you that yesterday, for the first time in the Russian media and on state television, information appeared about the detonation of a nuclear bomb by the Ukrainians in Nikolaev, which will lead to the involvement of the USA.

Therefore, any detonation of the dam will create chain reactions that may even lead to a nuclear strike.

Logically, shelters will also begin to be prepared in other Russian cities while the level of nuclear preparedness of the strategic deterrent forces will rise.

We are essentially talking about a DEFCON 2 situation in Russia as the Russian leadership appears to be preparing for a possible US/NATO strike even on the Russian capital.

The classification of Defense readiness condition (DEFCON) is: 1) Nuclear or conventional war 2) One step before war, 3) Increased readiness of Units, 4) Vigilance and increased security measures and monitoring 5) Normal state of readiness.

Shelters are being prepared in Moscow

According to last-minute information, Moscow hospitals are equipping operating rooms in bomb shelters, said a "source from the medical sector of the Russian capital".

Signs with the inscription "Shelter" appeared at the city's children's polyclinic No. 110.

Information indicates that such shelters are being prepared at Yudin Hospital, as well as City Clinical Hospital No. 31.

"There used to be offices for employees, where doctors could eat or change. Now in the basement it will be possible to hide from something unknown.

They sort out the trash that has accumulated in the basement. In addition, they provide light and communications to the shelters and carry water, lanterns and disposable tableware," writes Russian media.

At the same time, the Ministry of Education of Russia, following the Ministry of Health, was ordered **to equip bomb shelters in institutions under it.**

It is no coincidence that in the last 24 hours, Iran's foreign ministry advised its citizens to refrain from traveling to Ukraine and asked Iranians there to leave the country immediately

India and Vietnam followed by asking their citizens to leave Ukraine.

Blowing up the Kakhovskaya dam: Scenarios for the evolution of the disaster

Russian media are talking about the imminent destruction of the Kakhovskaya dam. They specifically mention:

"The Kakhovskaya hydroelectric station is one of the glorious projects of the great communist construction projects of the Soviet Union. The town of Novaya Kakhovka was created only for the service of the hydroelectric power station staff and family members.

The hydroelectric complex was put into operation simultaneously with the completion of the installation of the sixth hydroelectric unit of the station in 1956. It is a typical lowland hydroelectric station, the lowest of the cascade of the Dnieper dams. The total length of the dam is over 3.8 kilometers and it holds the Kakhovka reservoir with a volume of 18.2 cubic kilometers. This is the largest reservoir on the Dnieper and at the same time the main source of water supply for the entire south.

Only a 16.5 meter dam, which Ukrainian nationalists are threatening to blow up, prevents the giant mass of water from escaping. The act of terrorism serves many Ukrainian goals at the same time.

The first objective is the physical destruction of the civilian population that wanted to come under Russian control. The territory downstream of the Dnieper is now part of Russian territory.

The second reason is the destruction of the waterways in the Kherson area. They are used both to supply the group of Russian troops on the left bank of the Dnieper, and as a humanitarian corridor between the regions of Kherson.

How the Ukrainians will strike

The first information about the preparation by Kyiv of a massive missile attack on the Kakhovskaya hydroelectric station appeared on October 18. According to the commander of the Russian troops in

the zone of the special military operation, General Sergei Surovikin, "these actions can lead to the destruction of the infrastructure of a large industrial center and heavy civilian casualties".

We can say that a hydroelectric power station is a good target for the Armed Forces of Ukraine. Ukrainian rockets and shells have been destroying rail and road bridges at the dam since the summer.

The target is within range of both artillery and HIMARS guided missiles. Of course, the destruction of a powerful hydraulic structure will not be achieved immediately. The Ukrainians do not have concrete-piercing ammunition. GMLRS missiles are more focused on destroying manpower and light equipment.

But methodical and deliberate blows to the body of the Kakhovskaya hydroelectric power station can cause a significant crack in the dam. Of course, the Ukrainians can use not only guided missiles, but the "smart" 152 mm Excalibur missile.

According to estimates, the concentration of fire with the means available to the Armed Forces of Ukraine can cause the barrier to be breached as early as the second or third day depending on the reaction of local air defenses. And here everything will depend on the level at which the Kakhovka reservoir is now.

How can the Ukrainian terrorist attack be prevented?

According to the Deputy Governor of the Kherson region, Volodymyr Saldo, the intensive discharge of water through the dam has been organized and the population is moving away from the left bank of the Dnieper.

At the same time, the discharge of water from the Kakhovka Reservoir can be increased through the North Crimean Canal, which is located upstream.

The Consequences – Massive humanitarian disaster

Modeling the consequences of the hydroelectric dam disaster shows Apocalypse images for the Kherson area. In the worst case scenario, the nationalists manage to destroy the dam.

To do this, they use both the aforementioned guided missiles and river mines, which have already been introduced near the settlement of Gavrilovka. Don't rule out sabotage. And although the average depth of the Kakhovka reservoir is not so great – only eight meters, it is enough to reach the upstream of the dam.

Did anyone believe that in the fall of 2022, gas pipelines at the bottom of the Baltic Sea and a truck full of explosives would blow up on the Crimean bridge?

In any case, the situation will become catastrophic when one of the sections of the dam is completely destroyed. Kilometers of water accumulated in the reservoir will equalize the level before and after the hydroelectric plant in just a few days.

The wave will sweep away the regional center of Golaya Pristan, as well as several small settlements. On the left bank of the Kherson, the water will rise by 2-2.5 meters – things will not lead to absolute chaos, but a sanitary disaster is guaranteed.

Local authorities will either have to evacuate up to fifty thousand of the local population, or fight contamination and other flooding for months. Not to mention the difficulties of the approaching winter.

The most rapid and devastating consequences await the residents of the areas downstream of HPP Kakhovskaya. The rapid flow of water will expose the water intakes of most settlements on the coast. First of all, Energodar. Emergency services will not be able to quickly deal with the consequences of the disaster in conditions of hostilities, this will take months.

If, downstream of the Dnieper, the water finally recedes, allowing hope for stabilization of the sanitary situation, then at the top of the hydroelectric station we will have to forget about the previous level of the reservoir for years. Even if the dam is repaired immediately.

Nuclear danger

In addition to hygiene problems, there are also serious technical risks. Thus, the cooling system of the Zaporizhzhya NPP is fed by the waters of the reservoir. Here the need is so great that no direct drilling well can solve the problem.

In addition, the drilling should be deeper than usual, with the loss of water the groundwater level will decrease.

It is needless to comment on what could happen if there is an overheating of the reactor cores of the largest nuclear power plant in Europe. We only note that the dispersion of several tens of tons of uranium fuel as a result of an accident is much more serious than the consequences of a nuclear strike. Of course, without considering the damage from the shock wave.

The North Crimean Canal, unblocked by Russian troops, is fed by the Kakhovka Reservoir. Through this the peninsula receives water. A drop in water levels of 5-8 meters is guaranteed to leave many millions of people without fresh water.

Don't forget the delayed effects of dehydrating the area. The southern part of Ukraine is highly dependent on irrigation from the waters of the Kakhovka Reservoir. Here lives the agriculture of an essentially arid region. The 130 km long Kakhovka Canal is the key to the irrigation system in the south of the Kherson region. The negative effect of its drainage will be felt by hundreds of thousands of people next autumn, when the harvest will fail.

AN ABC NEWS INVESTIGATIVE JOURNALIST DISAPPEARED SIX MONTHS AGO. HE SEEMS TO HAVE KNOWN A LOT ABOUT AMERICAN AIMS IN UKRAINE

Has a potential whistleblower been 'disappeared' or is there another explanation?

On 27 April, ABC News reporter James Meek <u>tweeted</u> a single word – "facts" – above another Twitter post from a retired CIA officer, who stated that the 2014-2022 Ukrainian civil war was an eight-year "*lab* experiment" on Russia's military "tactics, techniques,

and procedures." It added that US intelligence and "unconventional warfare" experts had "learned a shit ton."

It was the last time, to date, Meek posted on the social network. In fact, it seems it was the last time he did anything in public at all, both online and in-real-life. Rolling Stone has <u>published</u> an investigation into the veteran journalist's vanishing act in the months since, revealing how just hours after that tweet

was posted, a number of menacing vehicles blocked off roads around Meek's apartment in Arlington, Virginia, then proceeded to raid the premises.

Neighbors interviewed by the magazine recall a collection of police cruisers, official-looking cars with blacked-out windows, and even armored tactical vehicles frequently used by the FBI, which resemble tanks. Quick as a flash, their occupants exited and rushed into Meek's apartment complex, "at least 10" of them being "heavily armed."

The raid was reportedly over very quickly, and Meek apparently didn't leave the scene with the authorities. To this day, there is no indication of what if anything was seized or why it was conducted, and all records related to the case remain sealed, including the search warrant approved a day prior. While no charges have officially been filed, Meek has dropped off the face of the Earth, and his apartment has remained vacant ever since.



At precisely this time, Meek is said to have resigned "very abruptly" from his ABC News post without warning or explanation, with even close coworkers unaware of the reasons for his departure.

He is also said to have telephoned Lieutenant Colonel Scott Mann, a retired Green Beret, with whom he was collaborating on an almost completed book, "Operation Pineapple Express: The Incredible Story of a Group of Americans Who Undertook One Last Mission and Honored a Promise in Afghanistan," to tell him he needed to withdraw from the project due to "serious personal issues." Meek was apparently "really distraught" during the call.



Almost immediately, Meek's name was <u>scrubbed</u> from the work's entry on US publishing giant Simon & Schuster's <u>website</u>, and its cover on various e-commerce sites listing it for pre-order. Several tweets from Meek promoting his involvement in the project have also been deleted.

Tell no tales

It's remarkable that it has taken six months for anyone to publicly raise the alarm over Meek's disappearance, and raise questions as to his whereabouts. One might think that a relatively high-profile veteran mainstream US journalist suddenly going missing would stoke concerns among his employers, if not fellow reporters, particularly given Meek's history of reporting on contentious topics.

He has previously broken stories on foiled terrorist attacks, and military cover-ups surrounding the fatal <u>ambush</u> of four Green Berets by ISIS in 2017, and the accidental death by friendly fire of US private James Sherrett II in 2008. The latter exposure resulted in Meek meeting personally with President Barack Obama.

To source such scoops would have necessitated maintaining close high-level contacts within Washington's national security apparatus – and there are clear indications Meek could himself have experience in that very sphere. As a 2013 ABC press release announcing the creation of a new investigative unit stated, since 2011 he'd "served as Senior Counterterrorism Advisor and Investigator for the House Committee on Homeland Security, grappling with some of the top threats to our country, including the bombing at the Boston Marathon."

What this grappling entailed isn't explained, although Rolling Stone interviews with his ABC peers indicate that despite his background being "shrouded in mystery," Meek was in close quarters at various times with military and intelligence professionals. One of his coworkers mentioned a photo in his office taken in a desert, featuring Meek posing with a number of people who had had their faces retrospectively blacked out.

These nuggets might suggest not only that Meek had a background in military and/or intelligence work, but that these professional exploits could have overlapped with his journalism career, perhaps up to the present day.

This interpretation is greatly reinforced by an underexplored disclosure in Rolling Stone's article. It is noted that unnamed sources had said "federal agents allegedly found classified information on Meek's laptop during their raid." One of Meek's ABC coworkers further told the magazine: "it would be highly unusual for a reporter or producer to keep any classified information on a computer." Which is true – but was he simply a "reporter or producer," or something else too?

Even stranger, Rolling Stone fails to put two and two together when discussing how it would be unusual and unprecedented for the FBI to seize a reporter's documents, as US laws make it illegal for journalistic material to be captured by federal prosecutors without special prior authorization from the US Attorney General's office, and there is no evidence in the public domain that such an agreement was officially reached.

Again though, such restrictions only apply to documents held by journalists – not regular citizens, or individuals involved in national security work. As such, Meek's final tweet – despite being posted after a warrant to search his home was secured – might be a highly incisive clue as to the rationale for the mysterious and completely unpublicized FBI raid.

Meek's <u>tweeting</u> about the situation in Ukraine since 24 February was fairly sparse, but on 4 March, he <u>revealed</u> that America's Germany-based 10th Special Forces Group had "spent a decade training Ukraine's special operations forces in unconventional warfare, almost exclusively. They are seeing those tactics being used very effectively against the Russian Bear."

In exposing this secret schooling, Meek was notably ahead of the curve – it is only since late September that Western news outlets have <u>acknowledged</u> the decade-long 10th Special Forces Group training provided to Kiev. This indicates he knew something the rest of the media didn't, or maybe wasn't allowed to mention at the time.

Meek's <u>other</u> posts on Ukraine suggest that while far from a Russian apologist, he was very critical of US policy in the region, particularly plans to ship endless weapons to Ukraine, believing it would be difficult for the cargo to reach the frontline, let alone be used very effectively by local troops. Both obvious outcomes have been subsequently <u>admitted</u>, leading to online backlash, and official denials.

The ABC journalist's knowledge of that covert training, and the US intelligence community exploiting the post-Maidan regime's brutal war on the Donbass civilian population as a petri dish for prepping war with Russia, strongly suggests insider access. Combined with public skepticism over Washington's war effort, could it be that Meek planned an expose of inconvenient hidden truths about the Western proxy war in Ukraine, or alternatively knew too much, and was dangerously well-positioned to publicize it?

Declassified <u>documents</u> reveal that the rule change protecting a journalist's possessions from seizure contain massive loopholes. If the FBI is trying to identify an individual who leaked documents to a reporter, or attempting to surveil someone they believe to be an intelligence operative, those protections evaporate, and the bureau can monitor privileged private communications without the Attorney General office's approval.

Were it the case that Meek was both a journalist and intelligence professional, by receiving sensitive briefings on US involvement in the war in Ukraine, he could have walked into a series of traps of his dual career's own making, with no legal protections, and no need for official sign-off on a massive spying and raid operation targeting him.

It is unknown quite what information he could have possessed that the US government wanted to suppress, although the White House is so desperate to maintain official narratives on the Russia/Ukraine conflict that it's giving direct briefings to Tik-Tok stars on the subject.

Of course, it's entirely conceivable that someone who could blow the whistle on how Russia's intervention was provoked, or what the US is trying to get out of prolonging the fighting, would need to be silenced as a matter of urgency.

Minister of Defense of Belarus: Poland is preparing forces

The political course followed by Poland shows clear signs of war and not defense, said the Minister of Defense of Belarus, Lt. Gen. Khrenin.

The Belarusian minister noted that the militarization of the neighboring states is progressing at an accelerated rate.

"First of all, Poland, whose political course shows Warsaw's preparation for a war that is not at all defensive.

Preparations have begun for not one, as reported, but two additional mechanized divisions of the ground forces.

At the same time, an additional section will also be located in the eastern part of the country near the city of Bialystok.

"The structure of the Polish territorial defense forces is also changing.

Ten battalions of territorial troops will appear on the border with the Republic of Belarus," he continued.

He added that in order to expand the military formations of the NATO forces, the military infrastructure is being developed at an accelerated pace on the territory of neighboring states.

Modernization of most airports in Poland is almost complete, ports are actively being improved to receive landing ships of the alliance, Khrenin noted.

"In Poland, Lithuania and Latvia, training centers and fields are being reconstructed to support the activities of NATO military forces.

New modular mobile camps are being built at an accelerated pace, capable of housing many thousands of military personnel.

An infrastructure has been established to ensure the rapid deployment and movement of US continental troops numbering up to an air force division and squadron. **That is, more than 20 thousand people.**

The deployment of the US missile defense base on Polish soil will significantly upset the balance of power in the region.

Offensive missile weapons can also be installed on its launchers, covering the entire territory of Belarus and most of the territory of Russia," Khrenin concluded.
