Intro to Ecclesiastes:

Ooheleth, found only in this book. It is "one plants & 15 animals mentioned in this song who assembles and addresses a group," as a "preacher." In Greek, the word "ekklesia" means "assembly" of those called out (the word for church). Latin "Ecclesiastes" is a **Setting**, perhaps early in reign, 965 BC., set in "speaker before an assembly."

A book of "preachings" by the "preacher." The to Egypt are mentioned. theme is the emptiness of mere human **Divisions**, Beginning of existence, without God.

Author: Identified in verse one as the Son of David, the King. A book of wisdom by the wisest man who ever lived up to that time.

Setting: Late in Solomon's life, about 935 BC, Israel.

Divisions: Thesis (all is vanity), 1:1-11. Proof, 1:12-6:12. Counsel for living with vanity, 7:1-12:14.

Christ: All of life empty without Him. Pictured as the one Shepherd?(12:11)
