Psalm 1

Blessed is the man
Who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly,
Nor stands in the path of sinners,
Nor sits in the seat of the scornful;
But his delight is in the law of the LORD,

Who is Jesus we know through the Psalms?

- Jesus is the Son of God (Psalm 2)
- Jesus died a horrible death on the cross (Psalm 22)
- But He is resurrected! (Psalm 16)
- And now reigns with power over DEATH (Psalm 8)
- As the perfect sacrifice, Jesus is our High Priest (Ps 110)
- So we don't offer further imperfect sacrifices, but serve Jesus by obeying the will of God (Psalm 40)

Who is Jesus we know through the Psalms?

Psalm 2 – Jesus, the Son of God

He who sits in the heavens shall laugh; the LORD shall hold them in derision.

Then He shall speak to them in His wrath,

And distress them in His deep displeasure:

"Yet I have set My King on My holy hill of Zion."

"I will declare the decree: the LORD has said to Me, 'You are My Son, today I have begotten You.

All those who see Me ridicule Me;

Psalm 22

I am poured out like water,
And all My bones are out of joint;
My heart is like wax;
It has melted within Me.

The congregation of the wicked has enclosed Me.

- Death of the Son of God was agony

Psalm 16 - The Resurrected Lord

Therefore my heart is glad, and my glory rejoices;
My flesh also will rest in hope.
For You will not leave my soul in Sheol,
Nor will You allow Your Holy One to see corruption.
You will show me the path of life;
In Your presence is fullness of joy;
At Your right hand are pleasures forevermore.

Psalm 16:9-11

"Jesus of Nazareth...you have taken by lawless hands, have crucified, and put to death...whom God raised up, having loosed the pains of death, because it was not possible that He should be held by it."

"...This Jesus God has raised up, of which we are all witnesses. Therefore being exalted to the right hand of God..."

"... Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly that God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Christ."

Psalm 8 – Power and Authority

O LORD, our Lord,
How excellent is Your name in all the earth,
Who have set Your glory above the heavens!
Out of the mouth of babes and nursing infants
You have ordained strength,
Because of Your enemies,
That You may silence the enemy and the avenger.

You have made him to have dominion over the works of Your hands; You have put all things under his feet,

Psalm 8

For since by man came death, by Man also came the resurrection of the dead. For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ all shall be made alive....

For He must reign till He has put all enemies under His feet. The last enemy that will be destroyed is death. For

"He has put all things under His feet."

- Jesus is King all things are under Him
 - 1 Corinthians 15:27
 - Ephesians 1:22
 - Hebrews 2:8
- This includes DEATH. It is subject to Jesus.

Psalm 110 - Our High Priest

The Lord said to my Lord,
"Sit at My right hand,
Till I make Your enemies Your footstool."

The Lord has sworn

And will not relent,

"You are a priest forever

According to the order of Melchizedek."

Psalm 110

Also there were many priests, because they were prevented by death from continuing. But He, because He continues forever, has an unchangeable priesthood. Therefore He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them.

For such a High Priest was fitting for us, who is holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, and has become higher than the heavens; who does not need daily, as those high priests, to offer up sacrifices, first for His own sins and then for the people's, for this He did once for all when He offered up Himself.

Hebrews 2:26-27

Psalm 40 - Serving God

My ears You have opened.
Burnt offering and sin offering You did not require.
Then I said,
"Behold, I come;
In the scroll of the book it is written of me.
I delight to do Your will, O my God,
And Your law is within my heart."

Sacrifice and offering You did not desire;

Therefore, when He came into the world, He said: "Sacrifice and offering you did not desire, but a body you have prepared for me. In burnt offerings and sacrifices for sin you had no pleasure. Then I said, 'behold, I have come— in the volume of the book it is written of me— to do your will, O God.' "

Previously saying, "Sacrifice and offering, burnt offerings, and offerings for sin you did not desire, nor had pleasure in them" (which are offered according to the law), then He said, "Behold, I have come to do your will, O God."

He <u>takes away</u> the **first** that He may <u>establish</u> the **second**. By that will we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.

Psalm 118 – The Foundation of the Church

The stone which the builders rejected Has become the chief cornerstone. This was the LORD's doing; It is marvellous in our eyes. This is the day the LORD has made; We will rejoice and be glad in it.
