Humans are Not Creators by Fred DeRuvo - Study-Grow-Know Ministries

It really does not matter whether or not the *source* of the message is an *alien*, *ascended master*, or *spirit guide*. In fact, it is likely that the *source* is exactly the same, in spite of what the messenger wants us to believe. What matters most is the message itself that's being relayed to humanity.

In virtually all cases – aliens, ascended masters, spirit guides – all speak of greater understanding, which to them means more *light*, as in getting more light on the subject. The more light there is in the world, the greater the understanding. The greater the understanding, the more people there are who are connected with that understanding. Ultimately, those beings in the fourth dimension want humanity to comprehend one thing: *we control our destiny*. There is no personal God, as in the Bible. What many call gods were at one time what we are now.

This is the message and of course it is a dangerous one, as we have learned, because it pushes God out of the picture completely. He is replaced with human beings, who come to believe – as did Lucifer – that we are gods and need no other outside of ourselves.

This lie, told boldly to adherents of the occult, the New Age movement, and a host of esoteric groups and societies, is one that takes root quickly within each individual because it caters to our *pride*. The more *impersonal* this light can become for us, the greater the chances that people will be willing to explore it.

Impersonal forces do not make people feel guilty over what may be considered to be *sin*. In fact, there is little in the world that is said to be truly evil. People who do bad things are simply working out their karma. Like all of us, they have many new lives in front of them to work things out. They will eventually climb on board with the rest of humanity, or they will be removed.

Those who masquerade as aliens and other entities do so because they want to deceive human beings into thinking that we are *self-made*. Think about it. Even evolutionists are now considering the concept that the true beginnings of life that occurred on this planet were seeded here by superior intellects from other planets, galaxies, or dimensions. Even if this could by some freak chance be remotely true, it *still* does not mean that human beings are gods. The idea that people have the inherent ability to control forces *outside* of themselves in order to become creators themselves is absurd because it goes against logic, yet that is what more and more people are doing. How can something that is created ever be more than *created*?

How is it possible for the *created* to be the *creator*? I'm not simply talking about being able to invent something, or to create something using materials that already exist. I'm talking about creating out of nothing. No one would be able to invent something if resources did not already exist on this planet.

Creation is a process that only God can accomplish because He created from nothing (*ex nihilo*; literally *out of nothing*). What human beings do is to *put together* aspects of God's Creation like a puzzle in order to make what was not *seen* before. This does not mean the resources were not there before. It simply means that whatever a person is said to have created was done by taking various *pre-existing elements*, doing something to them, or combining them in such a way as to make something new. Yet without those pre-existing elements and resources, nothing new would have been "created."

God is the only One who created something out of nothing. This we understand from the first chapter of Genesis. That is what it means to be a true Creator. What human beings do is more akin to being an alchemist.

Science takes the time to study existing aspects of the Creation. From those studies, determinations are made. Some of those determinations can be cataloguing or combining.

Recently, I watched a documentary on how far body armor has come. What used to weigh a great deal because it was made of steel now weighs far less than half that because good body armor is now made of porcelain covered in Kevlar. Who would have thought that the lighter weight porcelain would offer better protection than steel?

Did man create steel? Yes, by combining certain elements with fire. Did man create porcelain? Yes, by combining specific elements. Again, no one created the raw material that goes into the creation of either steel or porcelain. In that sense then, it cannot be accurately stated that man truly *creates*. At best, he comes up with a new way of combining elements to form something that has not been formed prior.

People are so quick to rule out the possibility of one, true, personal God because if He exists, that instantly means that people are responsible to Someone and must give an accounting of our lives. It makes sense that if God exists and He created, then naturally He would expect us to provide an accounting for how we lived in this life.

However, if we are *already* gods in some form, then the only one we answer to is *ourselves*. This is the thrust of the idea *behind* the message. It is to pull us further away from the God of the Bible so that we become more inward in our approach to life. This message is diametrically opposed to Scripture and it is diametrically opposed to Jesus, who spent His entire life submitting not to Himself, but to God the Father. Though God Himself, Jesus did

this to show humanity *how* we are to live. He also did this to fulfill every aspect of the law in order that He would become an acceptable sacrifice for our sin.

Here is the dilemma. Ever since humanity failed the test and opted to follow their own desires *away* from God, we have continued along those lines, hoping to find some way of avoiding the guilt that is associated with the road that takes people away from God. No one likes to feel guilty and when we do, we do one of two things:

- 1. Feel badly enough to confess it in the hopes of feeling relieved of the guilt, or
- 2. Dig in our heels because of our pride and refuse to acknowledge that something is wrong

In essence, the lie that we are being told today is a lie that keeps us from returning to God. It makes us think that we are all we need and if we will just learn to listen to our own inherent divinity, then all will be well with the world.

This is the lie that keeps people from God!
