

- v 2-3 *consume* (3x) - Webster 1828 def: To destroy as by fire.
Deuteronomy 32:22, Psalm 37:20 & 59:13
stumblingblocks - 1611 mr '*idols*' **Ezekiel 14:3-4, Isaiah 57:14-15**
- v 4 *Baal* - hx: **Judges 2:11-15**
Chemarims = 1611 mr **Hosea 10:5, 2 Kings 23:5** - *idolatrous priests* (wore black robes)
- v 5 *worship the host of heaven* - **Isaiah 47:13, Daniel 2:27-28**
Malcham = Ammonite god, 2 Kings 23:13, aka *Moloch*, **Acts 7:43** (*Remphan* = Saturn)
- v 6-7 *the day of the Lord* (22x in 12 bk) **Rom 2:5, 2 Thes 1:7-9**
 Isaiah 2:12, 13:6 & 9 Jeremiah 46:10 Ezekiel 13:5, 30:3
 Joel 1:15, 2:1&11, 3:14 Amos 5:18 & 20 Obadiah 15
 Zephaniah 1:7&14 Zechariah 14:1
 1 Corinthians 5:5 2 Corinthians 1:14 1 Thessalonians 5:2 2 Peter 3:10
- v 7-8 *the Lord bid his guests ...*
clothed with strange apparel hx: black robes doct: **Matt 22:9-12**
 As opposed to the required garment of - **Isaiah 61:10**
- v 9 *leap on the 'threshold'* (8x in Ezekiel) = to *defile God's holy name* **Eze (9:3) 43:8**
fill ... masters' houses with violence and deceit
- v 10 *fish gate* - N gate on W. side : led to Samaria and Damascus
- v 11 *Maktesh* (depression) - a valley N. of the city, near the fish gate where foreign merchants met
- v 12 *lees* = dregs, 1828 def: worthless, waste sediment of liquors; foreign matter on the bottom
I will search with candles - **Proverbs 20:27, Matt 5:15, Acts 7:59**
- v 13 = **Proverbs 13:22**
- v 14 *the day of the Lord* (2x) = Amos 5:18
- v 15 *that day* = *a day of trouble* - **Jeremiah 30:7, Daniel 12:1**
- v 16 *the trumpet and alarm* - **Jeremiah 4:19, Joel 2:1**
- v 17 Sin leads to spiritual blindness, a life of distress and wrath upon the soul at death.
- v 18 *fire of his jealousy* - **Ezekiel 36:5 & 38:19**
