

## *"THE FALL OF BABYLON" Part 6* REVELATION 18:9-19; SUPPORT SCRIPTURE


XI. THE VICTOR/VENDOR COLLABORATION A. A symbiosis of human depravity enhanced with supernatural twisted might and Babylonian unquenchable thirst Genesis 11:6 1. Creation is full of natural resources for the taking and the using 2. We are our own <u>authority</u> and <u>accountable</u> to no one but ourselves 3. It takes resources to pay for conquest; but conquest garners resources for market 4. It takes safety and protection to have free prosperous trade; prosperous swap 5. People are also <u>expendable</u> resources; they can accept conquest/domination or be moved 6. Collaboration will get anything desired B. The psychology of Babylonian symbiosis 1. Babylon is the *insatiable* desire for more 2. To have more one must work more or find a way to get someone else to work for him 3. To work more leads to greater stress/anxiety 4. Babylon is worldliness of 1 John 2:15 5. Babylon lures and seduces the depravity in man and uses it to get what she wants; he uses her to satisfy his desires and lusts C. Understanding the terms of this account 1. The wine of their fornication? a. Fornication is <u>perversion</u> of the Way

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b. Wine is a fermented, intoxicating drink used for celebrations Exodus 32:1-6 c. How does this mixed metaphor work? 2. The kings of the earth and Babylon commit fornication and make wine for the people a. Making wine - violent <u>crushing</u> of grapes to get the "blood" from them; given a little time to ferment, the people have wine with which to celebrate; overindulging is getting drunk b. They <u>crushed</u> the lives of those they conquered and took their possessions for themselves. The people "drank" the "wine" of those possessions XII. THE LOSS OF THE KINGS AND THE MERCHANTS A. The loss of the merchandise that made them <u>wealthy</u> with misused resources and objects of worship B. The loss of the self-lavished <u>glory</u> that decorated their Babylon and brought praise to them C. The loss of the use of other <u>human</u> <u>beings</u> for their own profit and pleasure D. The loss of their very own <u>souls</u>! They gained the world but lost their souls. E. They keep their <u>distance</u> from her lest they become a part of her just destruction F. The destruction of this decadent city is near the end of the Tribulation. It has been living this kind of lifestyle while all the judgment was going on. G. The 10 nation alliance <u>hates</u> the very opulent, wasteful, extravagance of the city.
