#### INTRO and QUESTIONS, LAMENTATIONS

The "dirges", "laments", "elegies" of  
Jeremiah. The funeral songs of the city of  
Jerusalem. 40 years of warning and abuse, but no "I  
told you so!"

This is another acrostic. Each chapter goes  
from "A to Z" (22 letters of Hebrew alphabet).  
Chapter 3 is 22 x 3. Written soon after destruction  
of Jerusalem, 586 BC.

5 poems: the destruction of Jerusalem(1),  
the anger of Jehovah (2), the prayer for mercy (3),  
the siege of Jerusalem (4), the prayer for  
restoration (5)

CHRIST. The prophet himself is like  
JESUS, who wept over the SAME CITY 6  
centuries later. Jeremiah's and Jesus' rejection  
shown in the book also: 1:12, 3:19, 2:15-16, 3:14  
&30.
