## Intro:

<u>Main Point of Text:</u> Jesus fulfills another prophecy about beginning His public ministry: it will glow around the globe.

<u>Sermon Point:</u> *Jesus is the Light of the World.* 

Move 1: At the beginning of Christ's public ministry the world's alarm clock went off.

This was scheduled. Vs. 14: "fulfilled ... spoken by the prophet" (theme: 1:22; 2:5, 15, 17, 23; 3:3; 3:17).

Birth line, birth, travels, hometown, baptism, boot camp (chs 1-4:11). Now begins active duty. Luke 4:14: And Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit into Galilee ... John prepared the way, gets out of the way: Vss. 12/17. Connection more clear in condensed version, Mark 1:14-15: Now after that John was put in prison, Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God, And saying, The time is fulfilled ... Eph. 5:14. Christ's coming brought "time of the reformation", "last days" Heb. 9:10; 1:1-3.

Move 2: The beginning of Christ's public ministry opened the shades of Israel's dark house. Father God sends His incarnate Son to enlighten His darkened household. Vss. 13/15 quotes Isa. 9:1-2: area was the outer region of Israel's kingdom; its residents became outcasts. Calvin on context: 1) 4 tribes of Northern Kingdom carried away in banishment to Assyria by king Tiglathpileser (2 Kg. 15:29); 2) king Shalmaneser finished the job (2 Kings 18:9); 3) worst still to come, prefigured in the end of Isaiah 8 (prophesied in Mt. 11:23 and later realized): yet 9:1-2 looks to restoration beyond Senacherib's death (2 Kings 19:36) – to God Personally and completely reclaiming His household by sending His Son (Heb. 3:6). J. Gill: first place destroyed in the Holy Land is the first to be restored. Judgment begins with God's house; but so does mercy. Mal. 4:2; Mt. 12:20 quoting Isa. 43:3. Vs. 16: "shadow of death" – Ps. 23:4.

Move 3: The beginning of Christ's public ministry flipped the switch on for the rest of the world. John preached to Jews in Judaea. Jesus preaches to Jews and Gentiles throughout the earth. He strategically begins in Capernaum. On the Sea of Galilee. On a very busy trade route between Damascus and Mediterranean Sea (ways to the Gentiles). Vss. 15-16: "Galilee of the Gentiles". On Israel's outskirts bordering other nations and mixed with their people. Here Christ also symbolically begins to fulfill Isa. 42:6 and Isa. 49:6 as born out in Acts 1:8 (and Mt. 28:19-20). Acts 13:47: ... so hath the Lord commanded us, saying, I have set thee to be a light of the Gentiles, that thou shouldest be for salvation unto the ends of the earth. Vs. 17: Acts 11:18: ... Then hath God also to the Gentiles granted repentance unto life. Acts 20:21; 2 Tim. 1:10; John 8:12; Mat. 5:14; Eph. 5:8; Phil. 2:15; Rev. 21:23; 22:16; 2 Pet. 1:19.
