**NOWHERE TO HIDE**

**Jeremiah 48:40-47**

**I. Doctrine: Despite All \_\_\_\_\_ to the Contrary, the Fall  
(and sin) Leave us *Nowhere to Escape* (from God)**

A. –Our first father (Adam) *Tried* this, \_\_\_\_\_ Suc-  
cess, (Gen. 3:8)

B. –ALL of *us* Try it, too—though it is \_\_\_\_\_ to Fail,  
(Jon. 1:3)

**III. How we May Deal \_\_\_\_\_ with Sin**

A. –By \_\_\_\_\_ To The Lord *About* it, (honestly, and  
humbly), (1 Jn. 1:8-10)

B. –By \_\_\_\_\_ Christ, (and hence despising sin),  
(Ps. 51:17)

**Key Phrase**—v. 44a: “*He who flees from the terror shall fall into the pit, and he who climbs out of the pit shall be caught in the snare.*” (ESV)

Aim: To find our refuge—always and only—in Jesus
