Christians are in a life long struggle against the embodiment of evil called Satan.

- 1. Satan's existence
 - a. His reality is doubted by the world
 - b. His existence is declared by the Bible.
 - i. He is mentioned seven times in the Old Testament –
 - ii. He is found in 19 New Testament books and is mentioned by all the authors.
 - iii. He is mentioned 15 times by the Lord Jesus himself. Mt 4:10 [1] Mt 25:41 [2] Lk 22:31 [3]
- 2. His origin and fall. Two Bible passages
 - a. Ezekiel 28: 12-19
 - i. Verse 12 full of wisdom and perfect in beauty
 - ii. Verse 13 -He had been in Eden the garden of God -
 - iii. Verse 13 He was a created being...
 - iv. Verse 14 He was an anointed guardian cherub
 - v. Verse 17 His heart was lifted up because of his beauty.
 - vi. Verse 15 iniquity was found in him.
 - b. Isaiah 14:12-15 Note the abandonment of God's will and promotion of self-will.
 - i. I will ascend see 2 cor 12:2 [4]
 - ii. I will exalt my throne
 - iii. I will sit upon the Mount... he wanted God's seat and authority.
 - iv. I will ascend about the heights of the clouds.
 - v. I will be like the most high. (el El-Elyon)
- 3. The personality of Satan
 - a. He is a real person (entity) 1 Cor 15:39-40 [4]
 - b. He possesses intelligence
 - i. 2 Co 2:11[5]
 - ii. <u>2 Co 11:3</u> [6]
 - c. He possesses a memory Mt 4:1-11 (Mt 4:6) [7]
 - d. He has a will 2 Tim 2:26 [8]

- e. He has emotions
 - i. Desire Lk 22:31 [9]
 - ii. Pride 1 Tim 3:6 [10]
 - iii. Wrath Revelation 12:12 [11] He is coming down to earth with Great Wrath.
- f. He is organized he takes over churches and synagogues (Rev 2:9)[12]; he promotes his own doctrines (1 Tim 4:1)[13] and reveals deep musings (Rev 2:4)
 - i. It is the Devil that organized the first rebellion against God (Rev 12:4) [14]
 - ii. It is the Devil that will organize the last rebellion against God (Rev 20:7-9). [15] This happens after he is loosed from the bottomless pit.
 - iii. It was the Devil that organized the systematic attack on Job Job 1-2
 - iv. The devil has his hierarchy Eph 6:12. [16]

 - d. He twists true doctrine Gen 3:1-4; Mt 4:6 [7]
 - e. He hinders the work of God. 1 Thes 2:18 [47]
 - f. He resist the prayers of God servants Dan. 10:12-13
 - g. He blinds the lost 2 Cor 4:4 [18]
 - h. He accuses the servants of God Zech 3:1-4 (look up); Rev 12:9-10 [23,30]
 - i. He lays snares or traps for believers. 1 Tim 3:7 [48]
 - j. He tempts -
 - k. He afflicts Lk 13:16; Acts 10:38 [49]
 - I. He deceives Rev 20:8-10 [50]
 - m. He destroys homes 1 Cor 7:3-5 [51]
 - n. He prompts disobedience to God 1 Chron 21:1 [52]; Jn 13:2 [53]; Acts 5:3 [54]
- 6. Satan's physical location(s)
 - a. <u>In heaven</u> as Lucifer the shinning cherub and music leader of heaven.

- b. **In heaven** as the accuser of believers
- c. **On earth** only, which will happen in the middle of Daniel's 70th week.
- d. In the **bottomless pit** under chains during the 1000 year reign of Christ
- e. **On earth** for one last time to recruit and reveal the rebellious. Rev 20:7-9
- f. In the <u>Lake of fire forever</u>. Let's look up that passage in Rev 20:1-10
- 7. Satan's limitations
 - a. He is not omnipresent
 - b. He is **omnipotent**
 - c. He is not omniscient
- 8. The Christians victory 1 John 4:4 [55]
 - a. Know our weakness Without Jesus we can do nothing. Jn 15:5-6 Vine and Branches
 - b. Know our strength I can do all things through Christ that strengthens me. Phil 4:13 [56]; Gal 2:20 [57]
 - c. Know Satan's weakness –1 Cor 10:13 [58] He hates resistance. (James 4:7) [59] and he cannot stand up to the blood of Jesus. (Rev 12:11) [60]
 - d. Know Satan's strengths, strategies and schemes. The deadly d's.
 - i. <u>Disappointment</u>, <u>discouragement</u>, <u>despair</u>, <u>doubt</u>, <u>disbelief</u>, <u>distraction</u>, <u>doublemindedness</u>, <u>dishonesty</u>, <u>deceit</u>, <u>delay</u>, <u>discord</u>, <u>and</u> <u>disobedience</u>.
