FIVE SIMPLE WAYS TO SPEAK THE GOSPEL

1. Ask a conversational question.
2. Ask to share what you believe.
3. Ask to tell your story.
4. Ask about their beliefs.
5. Ask them to read the Bible with you.

ACTS 14:15–17

- Humans share the same nature (v. 15).
- Human idolatry is empty and must be turned from (v. 15).
- Humans must submit to their Creator (v. 15).
- Human idolatry hasn't always been confronted like it is now (v. 16).
- All humans experience God's goodness throughout life (v. 17).

ACTS 17:22–31

- Humans are instinctively religious (vv. 22-23).
- Humans can't contain or even help their Creator (vv. 24-25).
- Human life is entirely given and sustained by God so we should seek him (vv. 25-27).
- Human idolatry hasn't always been confronted like it's being confronted now (v. 30).
- Every human should turn from ignorant idolatry and submit to God's appointed judge (vv. 30-31).

1. You are inescapably religious.
2. Your conceptions of God are empty, illogical, inconsistent, and wrong.
3. You are created by the Creator of all.
4. You experience so many of God's good provisions—gifts like life, rain, seasons, and satisfying food.
5. You will stand trial before the risen King.
