Vindication Genesis 31:33-42

Requires a commitment to:

- **I. I**nspection "that they may judge betwixt us both" (vs. 33-37) *Seeing that I am:*
 - A. Transparent "And Laban searched all the tent"
 - B. Truthful -"the custom of women is upon me"
 - C. Trustworthy "set it here before my...and thy brethren"
- II. Integrity "This twenty years have I been with thee" (vs. 38-40) Striving to be:
 - A. Ready "she goats have not cast their young"
 - B. Responsible "I bare the loss of it"
 - C. Resilient "sleep departed from my eyes"
- III. Inventory "God hath seen" (vs. 41-42)

 Surveying the:
 - A. Price "I served...fourteen years for thy two daughters"
 - B. Praise "Except the God of my father...been with me"
 - C. Providence "God hath seen... and rebuked thee"

Sentence Sermon:

"A clear conscience is essential for maintaining healthy relationships."
