#### Psalm 20

Intro: A Psalm for the new year

### I. Exposition:

- A. Prayer for the king's protection and deliverance (vv. 1-5)
  - God would protect him in time of trouble (v.1)
  - Give him help and support from above (v.2)
  - Accept his offering and grant him favor (v.3)
  - Grant him his heart's desire and prosper his plans (v.4)
  - Give us reason to rejoice over his salvation (vv.5,9)
- B. Confident proclamation (vv.6-8)
  - The Lord will save His anointed (v.6)
  - The Lord will grant us victory, because we trust in His name (vv.7-8)
