## FIGHTING FEAR WITH FEAR

Genesis 3: 6-10 and Jeremiah 32: 37-40

**Of course**, we have numerous fears (elaborate). **Oftentimes** fear is overcome with knowledge (darkness, water).

In the Spiritual realm the scriptures speak of two KINDS of ofearo.

- 1. There is NATURAL/LEGAL fear. This is ofearo of punishment.
- 2. **There** is REVERENTIAL õfearö. **This** õfearö gives REVERENCE to Godøs redemptive character. **It ALONE** overcomes LEGAL õfearö.

**FIRST**, there is the õfearö we are ALL born with. **This** õfearö is NATURAL õfearö. It is LEGAL õfearö. **It is** õfearö of punishment. **I.e. It is** õfearö that we have done something WRONG; that we DESERVE to be punished; and that we EXPECT to be punished (or we õfearö that we WILL BE or *could be* punished).

In our practical lives we experience (this) ofearo when we run a red light. And, this ofearo never (completely) goes away. Even though you are pretty sure youove done no wrong, when those blue lights come on, there is that moment.

Well, THIS õfearö had a BEGINNING. We can see its BEGINNING all the way back to the garden; all the way back to manøs FIRST õwrong doingö; all the way back to the book of Genesis, immediately after the fall of man. After rebelling against Godøs decree, Adam and Eve sewed fig leaves together to hide their õnakednessö.

Look at Genesis 3: 6-7 "And when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make one wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat.

7 And the eyes of them both were opened, and <u>they knew</u> that they were naked; and <u>they sewed</u> fig leaves together, and made themselves aprons."

Adam and Eve õknewö something they had not known before. They õknew they were nakedö. I.e. They (now) KNEW that they were exposed to something they had not previously been exposed to. They were (now) AFRAID that God would inflict the punishment on them He warned them about, "In the day you eat thereof, you shall surely die." And LEGAL õfearö was born. They õfearedö God. They õfearedö His just punishment. They õfearedö the death He had threatened.

**But**, their efforts to shield themselves from Godøs wrath were not enough. The õfig leavesö Adam and Eve sewed together did not OVERCOME; they did not DELIVER them from their LEGAL õfearö.

Look at Genesis 3: 8-10 "And they heard the voice of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day: and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God amongst the trees of the garden.

- 9 ¶ And the LORD God called unto Adam, and said unto him, Where art thou?
- 10 And he said, I heard thy voice in the garden, and <u>I was afraid</u>, because I was naked; <u>and I hid myself</u>."

**Although** Adam and Eve sewed õfig leavesö together to hide their exposure to Godøs wrath, it was not enough. **They** STILL saw it necessary to hide when God came calling. **And**, you can see õfearö was their motivator. "**I hid** because I was afraid. **And, I** was afraid because I was not certain that the õfig leavesö covered my exposure to the punishment I now deserved.ö Adam sought his own SOLUTION.

**How** does all this play out to the fallen sons and daughters of Adam? **THIS** õfearö had its beginning there in the garden. **Adam** sought his own SOLUTION to the sin problem. **He** sewed õfig leavesö. **He** õhidö from God. **But,** God did not leave him there. **He came** and showed him (Godøs) SOLUTION to fallen manøs new problem. **He slew** an animal, and clothed Adam and Eve in its skin (Genesis 3:21).

**But,** it is the (LEGAL) õfearö born in Adamøs rebellion that is passed on to every fallen son and daughter of Adam. **Just like** Adam, we THINK we can SOLVE our sin problem. **Just like** Adam, we THINK the solution to sin is in the DOING of the sinner. **It is** THIS õfearö that motivates every action of the unregenerate sinner, (although the unregenerate sinner is unaware that (this) õfearö is their motivator).

**Before** God delivers us from THIS õfearö, THIS õfearö is what MOVES us. **It is** what MOTIVATES us to DO everything we DO. **We desire** to AVOID punishment. **We** desire to be RIGHT with God. **So,** we DO! **We** worship. **We** reform our lives. **We** pray. **We** give. **We** õaccept Jesusö. **We** become zealously religious.

We (do) WHATEVER we can. We DO whatever we are told; whatever we are taught to DO. We DO whatever we think we need to do to avoid Godøs wrath and be in His favor. And every act of DOING is an attempt to avoid the punishment we know we deserve.

Every act of DOING is an attempt to avoid the punishment Godøs justice DEMANDS. Every act of DOING is an attempt to be RIGHT with God. All such acts of DOING are the products of LEGAL õfearö.

The scriptures declare that it is (this) ofearo (NATURAL/LEGAL) that causes sinners to seek and to see righteousness oin themselveso like the Pharisees of Christos day.

Look at Luke 18: 9 "And he spake this parable unto certain which trusted in themselves that they were righteous, and despised others:"

**Every** facet of this worldow religion (Cain) is a promotion of just such self-righteousness (righteousness WITHIN the sinner; righteousness in the DOING of sinners).

**Self-righteous** religion promotes what comes natural to fallen man. **Self-righteous** religion promotes NATURAL/LEGAL õfearö that causes all without exception by nature in EVERY generation to õgo about to establish a righteousness of their ownö.

Look at Romans 10: 1-3 "Brethren, my heart's desire and prayer to God for Israel is, that they might be saved.

- 2 For I bear them record that they have a zeal of God, but not according to knowledge.
- 3 For they being ignorant of God's righteousness, and going about to establish their own righteousness, have not submitted themselves unto the righteousness of God."

õ**Being** ignorant of Godøs righteousnessö is another way of saying that sinners are ignorant of Godøs solution to the sin problem. **THAT is** the õknowledgeö all by nature are ignorant of. **Fallen** man ALREADY knows some things. **He knows** he is a sinner. **He knows** that sin deserves punishment.

**But**, he is õignorant of Godøs righteousness. He is ignorant of Godøs solution to his sin problem. **Therefore**, he THINKS that if he is to be free from Godøs just punishment; he THINKS that if he is to be in Godøs favor, HE must DO something. **That is** why all by nature are guilty of õgoing about to establish a righteousness of our ownö (in opposition to Godøs righteousness).

õGoing about to establish a righteousness of our ownö is what the scriptures call õcommitting sinö. Look at John 8: 34 "Jesus answered them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whosoever committeth sin is the servant of sin."

"Committing sinö is walking in NATURAL/LEGAL õfearö. õCommitting sinö is trying to work out our OWN righteousness before God.

**õCommitting** sinö is trying to avoid the punishment we know our sin deserves. **It is** seeking the favor of God which we desire to have by OUR efforts.

"Committing sinö is NOT finding ALL of salvation in the doing and dying of Christ ALONE. A sinner commits sinö who imagines that (anything) IN THEM (even faith, even repentance, even reformation) makes up ANY PART of the CAUSE of God saving them. committing sinö is failing to cabideo in Christ and His finished work ALONE for all of salvation.

**NATURAL**/LEGAL õfearö causes all of us by nature to õgo about to establish a righteousness of our ownö. **And,** õgoing aboutí ö is õcommitting sinö. **And,** õcommitting sinö is bondage.

**Therefore,** this õfearö holds ALL of us in bondage, (although we are ignorant of this bondage). **By nature** we are ignorant that our actions are motivated by LEGAL õfearö. **And by** nature we are ignorant that our actions are holding us in BONDAGE to the sin that deceives us ALL.

(This) LEGAL õfearö, therefore, is the õfearö that (all) need to be delivered from. The scriptures tell us that DELIVERANCE from (this) õfearö (and the BONDAGE it holds us in) is one of the MAIN reasons Christ came.

Look at Hebrews 2: 14-15 "Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil;

15 And deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage."

**Sinners** need to be delivered from the õfear of deathö. **One of** the reasons Christ came was to õdeliverö (His sheep) from THIS õfearö. **He will** without fail deliver His sheep. **Until** He does, we are õsubject to the bondageö of THIS õfearö.

That is the first KIND of ofearo. It is NATURAL. It is LEGAL. It is ofearo of death; ofearo of punishment. It is the ofearo that causes us ALL to ofearo about to establish a righteousness of our owno. It is the ofearo that holds us ALL in bondage. It is the (only) ofearo we have BEFORE we come to the knowledge of Christ.

**It is** the ofearo that ALL need to be delivered FROM. **It is** the ofearo that Christ came to (and will w/o fail) deliver His sheep from.

The scriptures speak of a second KIND of õfearö. There is REVERENTIAL õfearö. There is õfearö that REGARDS Godøs redemptive character. There is õfearö that gives REVERENCE to the God who justifies the ungodly based on the imputed Righteousness of Christ ALONE.

God fights õfearö with õfearö. He fights LEGAL õfearö with REVERENTIAL õfearö. REVERENTIAL õfearö is what overcomes LEGAL õfearö. It doesn't ELIMINATE it. But, it does OVERCOME it in those who are taught of God.

**Let's** begin our understanding of this second KIND of ofearo by seeing that it is ABSENT in all of us by nature. **NONE** by nature have THIS ofearo (REVERENTIAL) in any degree. **Understand** first that Paul is writing about ALL without exception.

Look at Romans 3: 9 "What then? are we better than they? No, in no wise: for we have before proved both Jews and Gentiles, that they are all under sin;"

I mention this so that NONE can say, õThat may be true of some. But it is not true of me.ö What is written here is true of ALL. NO ONE is the exception. This is the õbottom lineö indictment on ALL the fallen sons and daughters of Adam.

**Let** me give you a summary of Romans 3: 10-18. õ**There** is none righteous. **There** is none that is seeking after God. **There** is none that is doing good. Here is the õbottom lineö.

Look at Romans 3: 18 "There is no fear of God before their eyes."

Now, I have already shown you that we (all) DO õfearö God. We (all) õfearö His wrath. We (all) õfearö His punishment. We (all) õfearö not being found in His favor. But, NONE have the õfearö that is mentioned here.

**NONE** have (any) degree of the ofearo that REVERENCES God redemptive character. **NONE** have ANY regard for what GOD has done to deliver sinners from His wrath and punishment.

**NONE** know God or regard Him as the just God and Savior He declares Himself to be. **ALL** by nature are ignorant of Godøs Righteousness. **NONE** by nature know what makes it RIGHT (Just) for God to show mercy to those who deserve nothing but His eternal wrath and judgment.

We have already seen the PROOF that THIS õfearö is ABSENT in all by nature. What is the PROOF?

**ALL** by nature are õgoing about to establish their own righteousnessö in OPPOSITION to õthe righteous of Godö revealed in the Gospel. **ALL** are õcommitting sinö. **ALL** are in õbondageö to the sin that deceives us. **And**, we go on here, although God always commands otherwise.

Gods commands sinners to ofearo Him. But, Godøs command is not to obe afraido of Him. It is, rather, to REVERE Him. It is to REGARD His Redemptive glory. It is to know Him and to HONOR Him as He reveals Himself to be in Isaiah 45: 21, "a Just God and Savior". God's command is to give glory to Him as the God who justifies the ungodly based on the imputed righteousness of Christ ALONE.

"Fear" God because that is where (true) knowledge BEGINS.

Look at Proverbs 1: 7 "The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge: but fools despise wisdom and instruction."

"Fear" God because that is where WISDOM begins and how it increases.

Look at Psalm 111: 10 "The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom: a good understanding have all they that do his commandments: his praise endureth for ever."

"Fear" God because it adds UNDERSTANDING to wisdom.

Look at Proverbs 9: 10 with Proverbs 4: 7-8 "The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the holy is understanding."

4: 7-8 "Wisdom is the principal thing; therefore get wisdom: and with all thy getting get understanding. 8 Exalt her, and she shall promote thee: she shall bring thee to honour, when thou dost embrace her."

**All that** we UNDERSTAND from this Book (aright) is through the knowledge of how God can remain Just when dealing mercifully with ungodly sinners.

"Fear" God because it is the owhole duty of mano.

Look at Ecclesiastes 12: 13-14 "Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: <u>Fear God, and keep his commandments</u>: for <u>this is the whole duty of man.</u>

14 For God shall bring every work into judgment, with every secret thing, whether it be good, or whether it be evil."

**The** final judgment of every work will be in reference to whether it was done in the REVERENTIAL õfearö or LEGAL õfearö. **What** is motivating the õworkö? **Is** it a REGARD for a Just God and Savior? **Is** it resting in Christ ALONE? **Or**, is it the õfearö of a õgodö who will punish you if YOU donøt DO and DO (more)?

God commands õfearö (a regard for His redemptive glory). How do sinners get this second KIND of õfearö? THIS õfearö is a gift of the Spirit. THIS õfearö is GIVEN in regeneration. None have THIS õfearö in any degree BEFORE then.

**This** is ofearo we (begin) to have (only) AFTER we come to the knowledge of Christ.

**This** is ofearo we (begin) to have (only) after the Spirit oshows us the things of Christo (i.e. causes us to value what CHRIST HAS DONE to osave His people from their sinso). **This** is ofearo we (begin) to have ONLY (after) The Spirit comes to us in power under the Gospel; ONLY (after) we are delivered to that form of doctrine that reveals a Just God and Savior.

Look at Romans 6: 17-18 "But God be thanked, that ye were the servants of sin, but ye have obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine which was delivered you.

18 Being then made free from sin, ye became the servants of righteousness."

Notice! None start out õservants of righteousnessö.

**One** more scripture on how sinners õgetö REVERENTIAL õfearö. He delivers us to the Gospel. **And,** He õputs His fearö in us.

Look at Jeremiah 32: 37-40 "Behold, I will gather them out of all countries, whither I have driven them in mine anger, and in my fury, and in great wrath; and I will bring them again unto this place, and I will cause them to dwell safely:

- 38 And they shall be my people, and I will be their God:
- 39 And I will give them one heart, and one way, that they may fear me for ever, for the good of them, and of their children after them:
- 40 And I will make an everlasting covenant with them, that I will not turn away from them, to do them good; but I will put my fear in their hearts, that they shall not depart from me."

God õputs His fearö in the hearts of His people. I.e. He reveals to them that the ONLY way He can be Just (doing right) in saving them and giving them all the benefits and blessings of His mercy and grace is by the finished work of Christ ALONE. He brings us to Himself through Christ crucified. And, He keeps us the same way. "They shall not depart from me." If you õfearö God, you canøt leave.

**Either**, Christ died for **you** AND His death ENDED **your** punishment. (I.e. There is NO possibility that you can EVER be punished.)

"By His stripes you are healed." You already have been and forever will be one of christosteath ALONE. You already are and forever will be (eternally) in Godos favor; He declares you unchangeably righteous because of Christos Righteousness imputed ALONE.

**OR**, you are facing the punishment you (justly) deserve without recourse (i.e. without any possibility of being delivered from that end).

**Under** a just God, there is no possibility that Christ died for you, yet, you are still facing the punishment He has already endured in your place. **In the** scriptures there is no such thing as Christ dying for a sinner and that sinner He died for being in any danger of punishment, any danger of eternal death.

In the Spiritual realm ofearo motivates everything we do. Question is, owhich ofearo? Is it the LEGAL ofearo that if we have not DONE and donot continue to DO, we could end up under the eternal wrath of God? Or, is it the REVERENTIAL ofearo that sees God just to save us, forgive us, and take us to heaven based on the merit of CHRIST work (HIS Righteousness) charged to our account (without ANY contribution from us)?

We all start out in LEGAL õfearö. We all start out under the õfearö of punishment. We all start out in the BONDAGE of õgoing aboutí ö. But, Christ will not leave a single, one of His sheep there. He will fight THAT õfearö and OVERCOME it with the õfearö that REGARDS His Fatherøs Redemptive glory.

"Fearö not little children. God will "put His fear in your heart that you shall not depart from Him".

**So,** I close by encouraging you, (whoever you are), to seek. **Seek** to be found in Christ and His Righteousness imputed alone. **Seek** the God who is Just to save by the merits of Christ obedience unto death ALONE. **Seek** the God who (in a people of his choosing), and in a people that He calls by His Gospel will not fail to FIGHT FEAR WITH FEAR.
