Yonah, "dove", sent to capital of pagan Assyria, refuses to go, is intercepted, brings a revival, gets discouraged, is reassured.(of interest: the storm, the lots, the sailors, the fish, the Ninevites, the plant, the worm, the east wind...ALL obey God. But not the prophet!) A contemporary of Jeroboam II (782-753 BC.) After Elisha, before Amos/Hosea. Israel reviving, Assyria becoming more cruel but weak. Plagues and solar eclipse there 765-759. CHRIST: Matthew 12:39-41. 3 days & 3 nights in belly of fish/earth. Christ's love for GENTILES.
