 - <2> Believer's Work Philippians 2:12-13; 1 Peter 1:14-16,22; 2 Corinthians 7:1; 1 John 3:2-3.
- (3rd) Perfect Sanctification 1 Corinthians 15:51-54

Question_#3 – Is it possible to communicate with the dead? – Deuteronomy 18:10-12... Isaiah 8:19-20... 2 Samuel 12:19-23... Luke 16:24-31... 1 Samuel 28:3-20> 1 Chronicles 10:13-14.

Question #4 - What about cremation?

(1 st) Whatever happens to the body after death, has no eternal significance – Ecclesiastes 3:20 John 5:28-29
(2 nd) Our bodies DO have eternal significance – Romans 8:22-25 1 Corinthians 6:19-20
(3 rd) Burning in the Bible symbolizes curse and condemnation because of sin – Leviticus 1 Joshua 7:25-26 Psalm 106:16-18 Matthew 13:40 John 15:6
(4 th) Burial (not cremation) is the Biblical mode of dealing with the body at death – Genesis 23:19 35:19 49:31 Deuteronomy 34:5-6 Luke 23:52-56
