- 1. We answered the first question: "Who is God, and how is He active in the world?"
 - A. God is one God who has always existed in three persons.
 - B. God is love, righteousness, and just.
 - C. God is Lord.
 - D. God created all things visible and invisible.
 - E. God provides for and controls all things.
- 2. Question 2: "Who are we and where did we come from?"
- 3. People have always struggled to understand, and with truth, answer this question.
- 4. God created the first man out of the earth. (Genesis 1:26-31, 2;7; 1 Corinthians 15:47)
- 5. God's creation of the first man from the ground is an important doctrine of Biblical Christianity.
- 6. The creation of man and woman is the pinnacle of God's creative activity to be more like Him than anything else He has made.
- 7. God took a rib from that man's side and made the first woman who became his wife and the mother of mankind. (Genesis 2:21-24, 3:20)
- 8. The Bible does not treat Adam and Eve as mythology but as real people. (1 Chronicles 1:1; Luke 3:38; Mark 10:6)
- 9. Our humble beginning from out of the ground reminds us that we owe our life and breath all that we are and all that we have to God.
- 10. God created man in His image for His glory. (Genesis 1:27; Isaiah 43:7)
- 11. This would have meant to the original readers, "Let Us make man to be *like* Us and to *represent* Us." (Genesis 5:3)
- 12. We as human beings are important to God Himself.
- 13. Therefore if we are truly important to God for all eternity then what greater measure of importance or purpose could we expect. (Psalm 16:11)
- 14. Man fell into sin and bondage referred to as the "Fall." (Ecclesiastes 7:29; Genesis 3:1-6; Romans 5:12-17)
- 15. Because of our flesh nature it is important to understand that we are spiritually dead.
- 16. We can see how tragically broken and empty of God's glory mankind has become. (Romans 3:23)
