Consider & Discuss (Be Transformed!)

- Verse 16 is comprised of 3 main clauses. Each clause uses a form of the verb "to think" translated in sequence by NASB as, "...be of the same mind... do not be haughty in mind... do not be wise... This same word is also employed 4 times in verse 3. And although a different greek word for 'mind' is used in verse 2, there Paul sets the stage of chapter 12 for the importance of the renewal of our minds, the change of our thinking? In what sense does right thinking lead out right action in general and in particular in regards to how we live with each other in the body of Christ?
- Community Group Discussion: How do we think by faith? How did Paul want his readers to think about themselves and the other members of the Church? In what way does the thinking of verse 16 explain the rejoicing and weeping encouraged in verse 15?
