HOW TO MASTER SIN

Ephesians 4:17-24

I.	Recognize sin is a matter of: v17
	InsistMust no longerWalk
	A matter of the will Q 1: Are you willing to recognize the power of your will?
II.	Recognize sin is because of: v17b-21
	No one would ever sin if they were thinking clearly.
	 Futility of their thinking Darkened in their understanding Ignorance due to hardened hearts Lost all sensitivity Contrast the truth that is in Jesus
	Q 2: Would you choose to take the 'red pill" that would unmask the deceptions of your temptations?
III.	Recognize and practice the Put – Put principle: v22-24
	The walk of faith is NOT simply to stop sinning, but always to replace sin with its opposite. Eg: T-shirts
	 Put off lying → put on truth telling (v25) Put off taking → put on giving (v28)

Put off bitter words → put on words that build up (v29)
Put off bitterness → put on kindness & forgiveness (v31-2)

- The expulsive power of a superior affection (4:32 5:2: next week)
- Q 3: Are you willing to intentionally pursue Christ in such a way that makes Him the most compelling thing in your life?
- IV. Recognize the need to **be** _____ in the way you think: v23-24
 - Not simply a moralistic decision (v17) but a new creation (v23-24, cf. 2:10) by God's Spirit.
 - This is the difference between joyful heart change and mere self-improvement that inevitably leads to ugly self-righteousness.
 - Q 4: Do you want to be renewed in your thinking and desires?

These 4 steps are at the root of seeing progress in overcoming root sins in your life.

And Jesus is at the root of the 4 steps.
