- 7. Who rejected this special building stone (v. 7)?
- 8. What is the relationship of those who reject Christ as the precious cornerstone laid by God (v. 8a)?
- 9. What is the ultimate reason why people stumble and reject Christ (v. 8b)?
- 10. What four descriptions does Peter give to identify God's people (v. 9a)? To whom did these descriptions originally apply?
- 11. What is the result of and goal toward which these descriptions of God's people lead (v. 9b)?
- 12. Who specifically are those who "once were not a people, but now are God's people" (v. 10)?
- 13. Why is it an honor to be a Christian? How is it an honor for you specifically?
- 14. What does it mean to have a special place in the Lord's Church?
- 15. Why do Christians sometimes feel isolated in the body of Christ? How can the Church prevent this from occurring? How can an individual member keep this from happening?
- 16. As a member of the Lord's Temple, how do you enjoy a feast in the house of the Lord?
- 17. In what sense is the Church an honored institution in the world today?
- 18. How do people discover the presence of God in the Church?
- 19. Do unbelievers come into contact with God when they enter the worshiping assembly of God's people? If so, how?
