He will come to His Temple: Luke 2:21-22 (Simeon's prophecy: v28-35); 2:41-50; ch 22-23: not then to judge but to BE JUDGED!)

But the Messenger produces division: 4:5: great & **dreadful Day**

4:6: repentance or curse

So John the Baptist: Matt 3:7-12 Jesus says he is the Elijah of Malachi (Mt 11:10, 14)

So the **Great Separation of the** _____:

Either FIRE

Or:

- Healing
- Leap like calves released from their stalls
- Tread on evil
- Written in the Lamb's Book of Life (3:16)
- His treasured possession (3:17)

Malachi ends abruptly, with the word "curse" NT ends with "grace of the Lord Jesus" (Rev 22:21) Do not presume; grace is by faith—not for everyone

So ends 32 years of the study of OT Messianic prophecies. Who could say they were lucky guesses? The warnings and promises are from the Living God. Heed!
