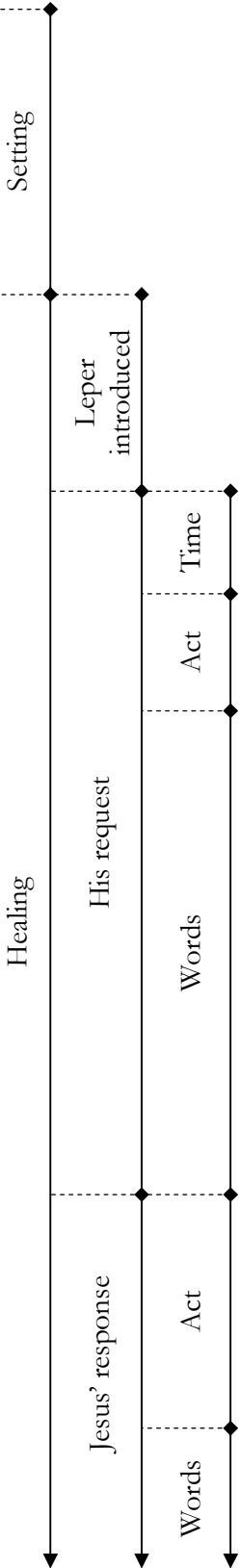
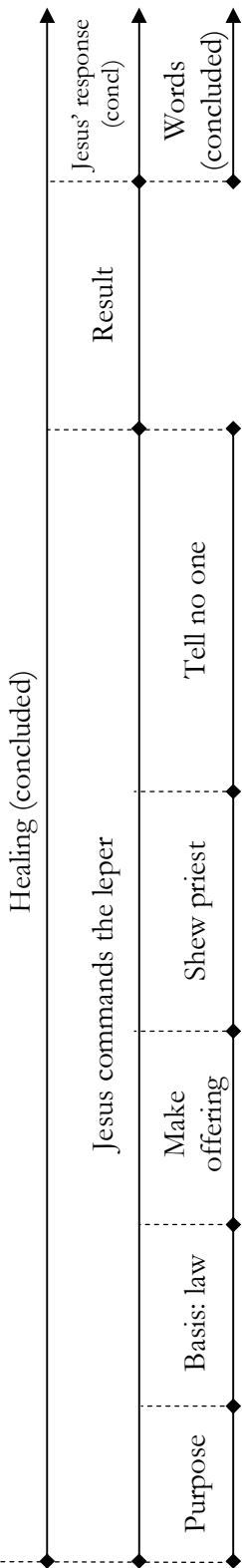


# Luke 5:12-16

*Jesus' ministry in Galilee: cleansing a leper, restoring an outcast*



<sup>12</sup> And it came to pass,  
when  
he  
was in  
a certain city,  
behold  
a man  
full of leprosy:  
who  
seeing Jesus  
fell  
on *his* face, and  
besought  
him,  
saying,  
“Lord,  
if thou wilt,  
thou  
canst make me  
clean.”<sup>13</sup> And  
he  
put forth  
*his* hand, and  
touched him,  
saying,



“I will:  
 be thou  
 clean.” And  
 immediately  
 the leprosy  
 departed  
 from him. <sup>14</sup> And

 to  
 tell  
 no man: but  
 “go, and  
 shew  
 thyself  
 to the priest, and  
 offer  
 for  
 thy cleansing,  
 according  
 as Moses  
 commanded,  
 for a testimony
