

SERMON NOTES

EVEN IN EXILE, GOD'S ELECT WILL BLESS HIM

...because:

I. <u>ALTHOUGH THEY ARE GRIEVED BY TRIALS, THEY WILL REJOICE.</u> "In this you rejoice, though now for a little while, if necessary, you have been grieved by various trials" (1 Pt. 1:6).

II. Their tested faith will result in Praise, Glory, & Honor. "...so that the tested genuineness of your faith...may...result in praise and glory and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ" (1 Pt. 1:7).

III. Their faith and love is a miraculous gift from God. "Though you have not seen him, you love him. Though you do not now see him, you believe in him" (1 Pt. 1:8)

IV. Their faith will turn into inexpressible and glorified joy. "...joy that is inexpressible and filled with glory, obtaining the outcome of your faith, the salvation of your souls" (1 Pt. 1:8-9).
