PROCLAIM THE FORGIVENESS OF SINS, Part 3 - Luke 24:47

INTRODUCTION

- 1. Thankful for forgiveness. Astounding!
 - i. <u>Isa 55:8-9</u> the incomprehensibility of God He is beyond us.
 - ii. Specifically His forgiveness $\underline{v6-7}$ an appeal & a promise
 - a. Consider God's innate holiness juxtaposed w/ our sin!
 - b. Seek, call, forsake, return repent & believe in God who pardons
- 2. Lk 24:46-47. forgiveness of sins.
 - i. Forgiveness is a revelation of YHWH [Ex 34:6-7]; based on His provision of propitiating sacrifice [1Jn 4:10].
 - ii. Forgiveness is imputed to believing sinners who repent: *seek, call, forsake & return*.
- 3. Today: repentant faith & our responsibility to proclaim this gospel

1st: Forgiveness is Given to All Who Call Upon the Lord in Faith

- 1. Paul did not call Gentiles to convert to Judaism b/c of the sole sufficiency of Jesus & the arrival of the NCov. He refuted the Judaizers who taught that obedience to OCov law plus faith in Jesus. Justification pardon & imputed righteousness is given on the basis of Jesus' obedient life & death.
- 2. Rom 9:30-33 Gentiles attain the righteousness wh/ is by faith
- 3. Rom 10:1-4 Paul desires kinsmen to submit to gospel
- 4. Rom 10:5-8 salvation by meritorious obedience must be perfect; you must do what Jes has, in fact, already done [cites Dt 30]
- 5. Rom 10:9-13 conscience: confession. Isa's seek, call, forsake & return!
- 6. Rom 10:14-17 promises are simply preached & believed

2nd: With Forgiveness We Are Reconciled to God in Jesus Christ

- -01. Salvation based on union w/ Jesus in His death & res [Rom 4:25].
- 2. Reconciliation w/ God
 - i. Rom 5:8-11 God propitiates His wrath & reconciles us to Him v1-2
 - ii. Eph 2:13-18 reconciliation tw/ men a new humanity
 - iii. Col 1:19-22 reconciliation is part of God's cosmic purpose

Applic #1: Jesus Christ Holds Us Responsible to Declare His Gospel-Defined Reconciliation

- 1. 2 Cor 5:18-6:2 v18, v19
 - i. explain reconciliation by imputed righteousness & forgiveness
 - ii. inform that today is day of salvation
- 2. Challenging but this is our responsibility in reliance on the HS.

Applic #2: Jesus Christ Holds Us Responsible to Demonstrate His Gospel-Defined Reconciliation

- 1. If your bro sins, rebuke him & if he repents, forgive him... Lord "Increase our faith!" [Lk 17:3-5] Why "faith"? cf. Mat 19 parable of unforgiving slave. Mat 18:35 My heavenly Father will also do the same to you, if each of you does not forgive his brother from your heart.
- 2. Peter requests increased faith [not sympathy, kindness, pity?]
 - **i.** Faith believes the gospel. As we experience the gospel of forgiveness we are enabled to give THAT gospel forgiveness to others.
- 3. Be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving each other, <u>just as</u> God in Christ also has forgiven you [Eph 4:32]. Just as = imitation: Eph 5:1-2 be <u>imitators</u> of God & walk in LOVE <u>just as</u> Christ also LOVED you.
 - **-0i**. We imitate Father as we give gospel-love to one another.
- **4.** We are *witnesses* of these things. Speak & show forth the gospel of astonishing forgiveness.
