 - A. Sin has no power over you (1-2)
 - 1. Abundance of grace demands obedience (1)

 - B. You are unified with Christ (3-4)
 - 1. You are unified in His death (3)
 - 2. You are unified in His life (4)
- II. Your future hope should change your perspective on sin. (5-11)
- A. You must realize your old slavery to sin is crucified with Christ (5-6)
 - 1. Your union with Christ in death is a guarantee of life with Him (5)
- 2. Your union with Christ in death is for the purpose of freeing you from your slavery to sin (6)
- B. You must realize your new freedom in Christ (7-9)
 - 1. You have died with Him. (7)
 - 2. You will live with Him. (8)
 - 3. Death's power over you is broken. (9)
- C. You must realize your new life in God (10-11)
 - 1. Christ has paid for your sin. (10)
 - 2. You must commit to a new way of thinking. (11)
- III. Your perspective on sin should change your actions. (12-14)
- A. You must reject sin's power over you (12-13a)
 - 1. You must guard against sinful thinking (12)
 - 2. You must guard against sinful actions (13a)
- B. You must submit to God's authority over you (13b-14)
- 1. You must commit to obeying God (13b)
- 2. You must rely on God's grace to obey Him (14)
