- I. Parable of the Places of Honor (7-15)
 - A. People pick for themselves places of honor
 - B. Jesus' instruction
 - C. Everyone who exalts himself will be humbled; he who humbles himself will be exalted
 - D. The principle extends to the invitation as well
 - E. Declaration by the attendees of the value of eating in the kingdom of God
- II. Parable of the Invitation (16-24)
 - A. A large dinner was given, and many were invited
 - B. Sent out a servant – tell those who have been invited it is time to come in
 - C. The excuses
 - D. The report: they won't come
 - E. The inclusion of those who are not usually invited
 - F. The original invitees? "They shall not taste of my dinner"
