January 23rd, 2022AM – Kevin Olivier **Proverbs 31:10-31** – "The Excellent Wife"

- A. One of the most important questions you can ever ask is, "Who should I marry?"
- B. This chapter of Proverbs includes Holy Spirit-inspired wisdom from a godly woman to her son Lemuel to be a wise king.
 - 1. A key part of advice from a godly mother was for her son to avoid ungodly women \rightarrow (v3)
 - Prov 6:26a "For on account of a harlot one is reduced to a loaf [crust] of bread"
 - 2. King Lemuel is told to give his heart to an excellent, godly wife who fears the Lord.
 - 3. Men should also pay special attention to today's text.

I. HER INGENUITY & DILIGENCE

A. She is not satisfied with mediocrity: \rightarrow <u>vv13-19</u>: "She looks for wool & flax & works with her hands in delight. ¹⁴She is like merchant ships; she brings her food from afar.

- 1. A temptation in America is to do just enough to "get-by."
- 2. What is exceptional about the excellent wife is that she finds pleasure in her work; **v13** says she **"works with her hands in delight"**
 - a. She even enjoys what others consider as chores (cooking) or hard work (agriculture).
 - b. She found noble, God-given purpose in her work. God gives her satisfaction when she does a job to His glory. 18a: "She senses that her gain is good;..."
- 3. She goes above & beyond what is expected of her. It should be the job of her maidens to prepare food for her & the household yet <u>v15</u> says...
- 4. Rather than being mediocre or ordinary in the kitchen, "She is like merchant ships; she brings her food from afar."
- B. The excellent wife has ingenuity to help earn money for her household.
 - 1. In <u>v16</u>, she manages money well by investing it to make a profit: "She considers a field & buys it; from her earnings she plants a vineyard."... (v4)"She makes linen garments & sells them, & supplies belts to the tradesmen."
 - a. She looks at ways to make money that in turn can be used to make more money.
 - b. God has given her wisdom to consider properties & materials that can be profitable.
 - 2. Weaving fabric by hand may not be the wisest means to make money for your family.
- C. The txt says she is an amazingly diligent person.
 - 1. She exercises not so she can look in the mirror but instead so she can be more capable worker. (v17) "She girds herself with strength & makes her arms strong."
 - 2. She rises early in the morning while it is still dark (v15) yet works past dark; v18 says "her lamp does not go out at night" while she works at the distaff & spindle (v19).
 - 3. Her motivation towards diligence is found in v27 & again in vv21-22.

II. HER GODLINESS

- A. She is a faithful spouse; $\rightarrow v12$ "She does him good & not evil all the days of her life."
 - 1. Here we have to read between the lines here; Solomon said in <u>Eccles 7</u>: "Indeed, there is not a righteous man on earth who *continually* does good & who never sins."
 - a. No doubt such a woman speaks her mind to him, yet does so in a way that is respectful.
 - b. She remains faithful to him alone & doesn't let her affections drift to another man.
 - 2. <u>v12</u> is a call for us to keep our wedding vows.
- B. Her faith in God is accompanied by evidential good works; <u>v20</u> says "She extends her hand to the poor, & she stretches out her hands to the needy."
 - Caring for widows & orphans as pure & undefiled religion in the sight of God (Ja 1:27) is not just the work of deacons. The **Proverbs 31** woman took it to heart as well.
- C. The excellent wife is filled with the fruit of the Holy Spirit according to $\underline{vv25-26}$. \rightarrow Turn there.
 - 1. This verse proves that God wants us to be optimistic rather than pessimistic.
 - 2. Turn to **Gal 5:19-25**
- D. Above all, her godly trait that is the driving force behind her diligence, kindness, generosity, wisdom, & faith is her wholesome fear of the Lord. → Turn to **v30**.
 - It is impossible for there to be a modern-day <u>Proverbs 31</u> woman unless she is united to Christ by faith. In <u>Jn 15:5</u> Jesus said, "I am the vine, you are the branches; he who abides in Me & I in him, he bears much fruit, for apart from Me you can do nothing."

III. THE FRUIT OF HER WAYS

- A. Trust (v11a) "The heart of her husband trusts in her,..."
 - 1. Any fruitful marriage needs to be built on trust.
 - 2. Such an excellent wife can be trusted— she can be depended upon.
 - a. A 1980s band called the Styx wrote a song called "She cares."
 - b A woman filled with the Holy Spirit who fears God & clothes herself with strength, dignity, kindness, & divine wisdom can be trusted because she is of a supernatural origin.
- B. Another fruit her husband has through her is that "... he will have no lack of gain" (11b).
 - 1. Her diligence produces wealth rather than wastes it.
 - 2. Because of she is an excellent, kind, diligent, generous, & faithful wife, her husband gets a good reputation that is a blessing in almost anything he does in the community. \rightarrow Look at v23.
- C. Such an excellent wife is praised by the community, but what matters more to her is that she is praised by her children & her husband. \rightarrow turn to (<u>vv28-31</u>)
 - 1. The Hebrew word for "praise" can be transliterated as "hll." "Halleluiah" is to praise Yahweh.
 - a. To sing "Halleluiah" is for God alone yet there is an appropriate use of praise for the ones we love.
 - b. There is still a place for such praise in marriage as we get up in age in our marriage.
 - 2. What is praise worthy of the excellent wife is her selfless service to her husband, children, & even to the poor & needy. That is what makes her noble & exceptional.
