


Abram Defeated Four Eastern Kings: Genesis 14:1-14




All these were joined together in the vale of Siddim, which is the salt sea.


And the vale of Siddim was full of slimepits; and the kings of Sodom and Gomorrah fled, and fell there; and they that remained fled to the mountain.


And they took all the goods of Sodom and Gomorrah, and all their victuals, and went their way.




2. The call for courageous faith: Abram, the Hebrew, was sought out (v.13).



3. The wise preparation of courageous faith (v.13).




4. The duty of courageous faith: Abram rescued his brother (v.14).

Abram Rescues Lot (14:13-16)




5. The wisdom of courageous faith (v.14-15).


6. The compassion and unselfishness of courageous faith (v.16).

7. The worldly honor: represented in the king of Sodom (v.17).


And the king of Sodom went out to meet him after his return from the slaughter of Chedorlaomer, and of the kings that were with him, at the valley the king's dale.

And Melchizedek king of Salem brought forth bread and wine: and he was the priest of the most high God.



And blessed be the most high God, which hath delivered thine enemies into thy hand. And he gave The Battle of Siddim him tithes of all.




