

PAUL COMMENDS TIMOTHY AS AN EXAMPLE OF THE LOVE AND SERVICE OF CHRIST

What made Timothy so commendable?

I. <u>Timothy had proven his worth to the church.</u> "But you know Timothy's proven worth…" (Phil. 2:22).

II. TIMOTHY WAS A SUBMISSIVE SERVANT.

"...as a son with a father he has served with me in the gospel. I hope therefore to send him just as soon as I see how it will go with me" (Phil. 2:22-23).

III. TIMOTHY ADOPTED THE INTERESTS OF JESUS CHRIST.

"For I have no one like him, who will be genuinely concerned for your welfare. For they all seek their own interests, not those of Jesus Christ." (Phil. 2:20-21).
