FOR US OR AGAINST US Joshua 5: 13-15

You will remember that God has (miraculously) delivered the nation Israel into Canaan, the Promised Land. They have submitted to circumcision (which had been neglected by their fathers in the wilderness). They have kept the Passover. The manna has ceased and they are eating of the oold corno of the land.

They are encamped at Gilgal on the outskirts of Jericho, which will be the first obstacle in their conquest of Canaan. **They** are NOW ready to begin their POSSESSION of the land before them.

Look at Joshua 5: 13 "And it came to pass, when Joshua was by Jericho, that he lifted up his eyes and looked, and, behold, there stood a man over against him with his sword drawn in his hand: and Joshua went unto him, and said unto him, Art thou for us, or for our adversaries?"

Joshua was õby Jerichoö. Jericho was destined to be Israeløs first encounter with the inhabitants of Canaan. It was the first obstacle standing between them taking POSSESSION of this land. Maybe Joshua was contemplating his next move. Maybe he was praying. Maybe he was mediating. There is really no way to know for sure.

But, he õlifted up his eyesö, indicating that he was (perhaps) in some mode of contemplation, and (perhaps) startled. He saw õa manö, one indicating his readiness to fight (his sword was drawn). And, Joshua went to this õmanö with his most urgent question. õAre you for us?ö Or, õare you for our adversariesö (i.e. õAre you FOR us, OR are you for those who stand OPPOSED to us)?

Are you for US? **Who** is represented in the õUSÖ? **It is** Godøs chosen/set apart nation. **It is** the nation which God had DETERMINED to POSSESS this land of Canaan. **It is** those who had been given this land in a promise to their father Abraham over 400 years earlier. **It is** those CERTAIN to POSSESS this land of Promise.

Joshua is asking this omano, are you for US. **God** has brought US here to POSSESS this land. **Are** you for US in this endeavor?

And, õAre you FOR usö? Will you be using your õswordö for OUR benefit? Can we count on your support? Are you FOR us?

Spiritually and TYPICALLY, the õUSö is those CHOSEN of God IN CHRIST and given all the benefits and blessings of õgraceö (in Him) before the world began.

Look at II Timothy 1: 8-9 "Be not thou therefore ashamed of the testimony of our Lord, nor of me his prisoner: but be thou partaker of the afflictions of the gospel according to the power of God; 9 Who hath saved <u>us</u>, and called <u>us</u> with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to his own purpose and grace, which was given <u>us</u> in Christ Jesus before the world began."

Are you FOR those chosen by God and redeemed by Christ. **Are** you FOR each of them POSSESSING, enjoying, resting in the salvation they were given in Christ before the world began?

OR, are you AGAINST us? **Who** represented those AGAINST Israel? **It was** ANY who stood in opposition to them OCCUPYING (POSSESSING) the land God had given them. **These** did not know they were standing in opposition to what God had ordained and what was CERTAIN to take place. **God** had (already) DETERMINED that Israel OCCUPY this land. He had (ALREADY) ORDAINED that they POSSESS it as their own.

In the Scriptures the question Joshua asks is (always) EITHER/OR. When it comes to the salvation of God, when it comes to the people of God, you MUST either be FOR us or you are (automatically) AGAINST us. That is what Christ told those who accused him of casting out demons by Beelzebub.

Look at Matthew 12: 30 "He that is not with me is against me; and he that gathereth not with me scattereth abroad."

When it comes to the people of God and their eternal well being, there is no straddling of the fence. You are either working IN behalf of Godøs chosen people. You are FOR them. OR, you are (automatically) working AGAINST them.

You are either working FOR a salvation that sinners õobtainö by THEIR doing. (I.e. You are either encouraging sinners to DO (something) in order to õget savedö.) OR, you are working FOR sinners to POSSESS (that) salvation which Christ has ALREADY obtained for them. Paul, the Apostle, said that he was working FOR the latter.

Look at II Timothy 2: 10 "Therefore I endure all things for the elect's sakes, that they may also obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory."

Paul never said that his work was to show sinners what THEY must do to õgetö themselves saved. That selegalism. **There** is something to be done. **There** is MUCH being done (BY and IN those sinners whom God has regenerated). **But**, NOTHING being done BY them or IN them is to GAIN or MAINTAIN salvation.

Joshua knew that God was FOR National Israel. He knew that He was FOR them POSSESSING the Promised Land. He is asking this "man", õAre (you) FOR us, or AGAINST us?ö Has God sent YOU as an ally or an enemy? And, this "man" responds.

Look at Joshua 5: 14 "And he said, Nay; but as captain of the host of the LORD am I now come. And Joshua fell on his face to the earth, and did worship, and said unto him, What saith my lord unto his servant?"

In response to Joshuaøs question, the õmanö said, "Nay". I am NOT for your adversaries. I am NOT for those who would oppose you. But, I am FOR the <u>LORD</u>. I am FOR Jehovah who saves. I am FOR the carrying out of His purposes. In fact, I am the õCaptainö of those whom God is FOR. I am the õCaptain of His hostö. I am Godøs õCaptainö sent to insure that ALL of Godøs purposes are fulfilled, especially those concerning the salvation of His people.

Who was God FOR in the book of Joshua? National Israel/ POSSESSION of Canaan.

And, National Israeløs POSSESSION of the Promised Land did (indeed) concern the (eternal) salvation of Godøs people. National Israeløs POSSESSION of this land is TYPICAL of Spiritual Israeløs POSSESSION of salvation.

God brought Israel to REST in this land they were given by Promise. **And,** He did so to TYPIFY His bringing His elect to REST in the salvation they were given in Christ before the world began.

It was (vitally) important that the TYPE not fail in order to insure that its ANTI-TYPE would not fail. National Israel (the TYPE) MUST (possess) Canaan, because Spiritual Israel (the ANTI-TYPE/Godøs elect) MUST (possess) the salvation they have ALREADY been given in Christ.

That is why ofthe Captain of the Lordøs hostö has come. **The** mission standing before Joshua and Israel is VITAL. **It** MUST NOT fail. **It** MUST succeed. **And,** its success depends ENTIRELY upon God.

That is why He sent Christ, the (eternal) õCaptain of His hostö to encourage Joshua, the (temporary) Captain of National Israeløs fighting forces. **He** wanted Joshua to know that God was FOR National Israel. **He** was FOR them POSSESSING this land they had been given. **He** was FOR each (individual) family POSSESSING their portion of this land.

And, NOTHING could stand in their way. NOTHING could stop their success in this matter; because: "What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us?" (Rom 8: 31). If God is FOR anyone, whether National Israeløs POSSESSION of Canaan, or Spiritual Israeløs POSSESSION of (eternal) salvation, who can thwart it or stop it?

Look at Daniel 4: 35 "And all the inhabitants of the earth are reputed as nothing: and <u>he doeth according to his will</u> in the army of heaven, and among the inhabitants of the earth: <u>and none can stay his hand, or say unto him, What doest thou?"</u>

Now, when othe Captain of the Lordøs hostö made Joshua to understand who He was, and why He came, and who He was FOR, Joshuaøs PERCEPTION of this Person was changed. **He** saw Him to be God in human flesh.

Look back at Joshua 5: 14 õ"And he said, Nay; but as captain of the host of the LORD am I now come. And <u>Joshua fell on his face</u> to the earth, <u>and did worship</u>, and said unto him, What saith my lord unto his servant?"

Joshua no longer saw this One as a (mere) õmanö. He now saw Him to be God. He saw Him to be God in human flesh, (the God-man). He saw Him to be the One in whom "all of the fullness of the Godhead dwells bodily". Joshua was looking at a õmanö. But, he now saw that õmanö to ALSO be God.

And, he showed Him the REVERENCE He deserved. He õworshippedö Him. **Joshua** õworshippedö the One whom God had sent to GUARANTEE that National Israel POSSESS the land of Canaan.

God ALONE deserves such REVERENCE. **God** ALONE is to be worshipped. **When** Christ revealed Himself to Joshua (as God-man), he honored Him with worship.

õWho is God FOR in this world (in ANY generation)?ö Who is He FOR (right now)? He is FOR those who HONOR His Son. He is FOR those who seek Him (the Just God and Savior He is), THROUGH His Son.

How do you honor God as God? You honor His Son. How do you honor His Son? You honor His person. You honor His work. You honor His salvation. You honor His obedience unto death as that ALONE which enables God to justify (otherwise) ungodly sinners. You work in the behalf of those whom God is FOR. You oworshipo Him owhom God has sent".

That is what this age is all about. **God** is õseekingö sinners to worship Him (a Just God and Savior) through His Son. **That** is what Christ told the õwoman at the wellö.

Look at John 4: 22-23 "Ye worship ye know not what: we know what we worship: for salvation is of the Jews.

23 But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him."

If there are TRUE worshippers, there must also be FALSE worshippers. If there are those worshipping the true and living God, there must also be those worshipping õgodsö of their imaginations (I.e. those who worship, "they know not what")

God spoke to Israel in Isaiah 45: 20 "They have no knowledge that set up the wood of their graven image, and pray unto a god that cannot save."

Who do you (Who do I) worship? Is it the God who justifies the ungodly? Is it the God who saves through Christ, the God-man, His finished work to put away the sin of His people and bring in everlasting Righteousness by the sacrifice of Himself (all efforts by sinners excluded)? Is it the ocaptain of the LORD to hosto?

OR, is it one who claims to be, but, falls short of the criteria that would identify and distinguish him as such? **Joshua** oworshippedö this One whom he saw to be God and man in one person.

In verse 14 Joshua acknowledged this õmanö to be God. (**He** "worshippedö Him.) **In** verse 15 this õmanö made it (absolutely) CLEAR that He was God and why He came.

Look at Joshua 5: 15 "And the captain of the LORD'S host said unto Joshua, Loose thy shoe from off thy foot; for the place whereon thou standest is holy. And Joshua did so."

This is one of those pre-incarnate appearances of Christ. **He** came to Abraham on the plains of Mamre on His way to deliver Lot and destroy Sodom and Gomorrah.

He appeared to Moses in the õburning bushö. **He** wrestled with Jacob before He changed Jacobøs name to Israel.

Here, He appears to Joshua as "a man with a sword drawn in His hand". This õmanö, (Christ), had already acknowledged His deity. When Joshua worshipped Him, He did not protest. Had He NOT been worthy of Joshuaøs õworshipö, He would not have allowed it.

Here, (as He had done to Moses in the burning bush), He announces that the place He occupies is õholyö. **And,** commands Joshua to remove his shoes.

No doubt the place occupied by the God-man was holy. **It was** sanctified. **It was** set apart BECAUSE OF Christos presence. **They** were standing outside Jericho. And, as we will see in a later lesson, Jericho (and all that pertained to it) was utterly destroyed. **It was** destroyed because it was oaccursedo, which means it was DEVOTED to God.

But, there is another issue here. **That** issue is the GLORY of God. **All** of Godøs GLORY resides in Christ. **To see** Christ is to see God. **To know** Christ is to know God. To be in the presence of Christ is to be in the presence of Him who upholds Godøs GLORY. **Without** Christ (Person/work), there is no GLORY to God. **God's** GLORY (as a Just God and Savior) is in the õface of Jesus Christö.

Look at II Corinthians 4: 6 "For God, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ."

In the matter of National Israel POSSESSING the land of Canaan, it is not so much about Israel gaining/having a land to call their own, as it is God fulfilling His promise to Abraham to GIVE his descendants this land. It is MORE about Godøs faithfulness to His promise. It is MORE about upholding the honor of Godøs character. It is MORE about Godøs GLORY.

In the matter of (eternal) salvation it is not so much about sinners being saved as it is about God being GLORIFIED. It is about God doing what HE has PURPOSED to do.

He PURPOSED for National Israel to POSSESS the land of Canaan. **He** has purposed that Spiritual Israel know and worship Him as He is. (**I.e. to know** Him as a Just God and Savior; to POSSESS the salvation they were given in Christ before the world began.)

This salvation is CERTAIN because God has purposed it; **because** Christ has done everything necessary for Godøs elect to have it; **and**, because the Spirit is doing everything necessary for Spiritual Israel to POSSESS it.

Joshua was outside Jericho contemplating his next move. And, Christ came with His õsword drawn in His handö. Christ came to assure Joshua that the battle was HIS. He came because His Fatherøs GLORY was at stake. And, He came to command Joshuaøs worship and obedience.

Christ comes to His elect in the Gospel that same way. **He** reveals Himself as the One in whom all of Godøs redemptive glory rests and commands their worship and obedience.

Who is God FOR in this world (in ANY generation)? **He** if FOR those who WORSHIP Him, (a Just God and Savior). **He** is FOR those who come to Him THROUGH His Son (His finished work ALONE). **He** is FOR those who HONOR/REVERENCE the Son with ownshipo.

And, He if FOR those who REVERENCE His Son with oobedienceo.

Look back at Joshua 5: 15 "And the captain of the LORD'S host said unto Joshua, Loose thy shoe from off thy foot; for the place whereon thou standest is holy. And Joshua did so."

This command for Joshua to remove his shoes COULD BE a command for Joshua to cease his efforts and look to the õCaptain of the LORDøs hostö. This battle belongs to Him. Therefore, the victory is already assured.

And, õJoshua did soö. Joshua responded with OBEDIENCE. **That** is the ONLY (proper) response to One you truly see as Lord.

Look at Hebrews 5: 8-9 "Though he were a Son, yet learned he obedience by the things which he suffered;

9 And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation <u>unto all them that obey him;</u>"

He is the oauthor of eternal salvation unto all them that OBEY Himö; to all who come to Him, to all who rest in Him, to all who find all their hope of final glory in His doing and dying ALONE.

To NOT respond with OBEDIENCE to one you call Lord is a CONTRAST. **That** is what Christ said to those of His day.

Look at Luke 6: 46-47 "And why call ye me, Lord, Lord, and do not the things which I say? 47 Whosoever cometh to me, and heareth my sayings, and doeth them, I will shew you to whom he is like:" Context!

That is (exactly) what sinners do who CLAIM that their hope is in Christ, but go on trying to work out salvation by THEIR efforts; THEIR contributions; THEIR faith. They CLAIM that their (spiritual) house is built on a õrockö. But, then, INSIST that you are NOT saved UNTIL you õclose the dealö (with faith, reformation or good works).

EITHER Christ ACCOMPLISHED salvation for EVERY sinner He died for by His obedience unto death. **OR**, Christ just made salvation a POSSIBILITY; and, sinners must work it out (complete it/appropriate it) by THEIR efforts.

The first is the house built on the Rock; the latter the one on the sand. **To** obey God is to REST in that salvation Christ has ACCOMPLISHED for every sinner He lived and died for.

It is apparent that God saw the need for Joshua to know (without question) that He was FOR National Israel POSSESSION of the Promised Land. He sent His Son to confirm it. He sent Christ to remove all doubt. He sent Christ to make it happen (exactly) as it was purposed. He sent Christ to insure the GLORY of God in this matter.

It is equally important for Godøs people to know that He is FOR them (each of them) POSSESSING the salvation He has given them in Christ õbefore the foundation of the worldö.

So, He comes to them in the Gospel declaring who Christ is, (God-man). **He** comes to them declaring sin put away. **He** comes to them declaring righteousness established and imputed. **He** comes to them declaring salvation ACCOMPLISHED and CERTAIN to be revealed to all for whom Christ has lived and died.

He comes announcing that the battle has already been won; the victory already gained. **Christ** arose the victorious Savior of His people. **And**, He comes commanding all who hear to OBEY the Gospel. **He** comes commanding all who hear to REST in Christ in order that His sheep might be made manifest in each generation.

The õgood newsö of the Gospel is that, Christ has entered into heaven (itself), "having obtained eternal redemption for us" (Heb 9: 12).

The command of the Gospel is õremove your shoesö (I.e. Cease your efforts to õobtainö/work out salvation.) God's GLORY in salvation depends on Christøs work ALONE. Rest in the salvation Christ has ALREADY obtained for a people of Godøs choosing.

God commands His preachers in every generation, "Go into all the world and preach the Gospel to every creature". And, Christ commands all who hear the Gospel to find their oresto in Him.

Look at Matthew 11: 28-30 "Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.

29 Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls.

30 For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light."

Christ appeared to Joshua in the plains of Jericho to assure him that the success of the battles that lay before National Israel was not dependent on THEIR strength and power. **The** success of them POSSESSING the land they had been given was HIS hands, (not) THEIRS. **Joshua** responded with oworshipö and oobedienceö. **By** that he gave evidence that he was one whom God was FOR.

Christ comes to every Spiritual Israelite in the Gospel, declaring a SUCCESSFUL Savior, a FINISHED salvation; sin put away; righteousness established and imputed; God GLORIFIED as a Just God and Savior based on Christøs work ALONE.

Christ cannot and will not fail to bring each one that the Father has chosen, each one He has redeemed. **He** will send the Spirit to ocallo each of them to Himself. **This** is HIS (on-going) work in each generation as long as the world remains.

"All that the Father giveth Me shall come to Me." "Other sheep I have which are not of this fold; them I MUST bring."

In closing, is God is FOR you/me? **OR**, is He AGAINST us? "**How** have you responded to the Gospel?ö **Have** you seen the God-man Savior God has sent? **Have** you understood the salvation He has ALREADY worked out for those who were chosen in Him õbefore the foundation of the worldö? **Have** you RESTED all your hope of acceptance with God (all your salvation) in Christøs finished work ALONE? Have you seen that YOUR efforts are (totally) EXCLUDED in this matter?

Our answers to these questions will tell us (WITHOUT QUESTION) whether God is FOR US OR AGAINST US.
