"I will build my church"

- August, 1997 Our first Bible study
- October, 1998 Our first service
- 20 years 1% of church history

"I will build my church"

- "Church" is used 2x in the 4 Gospels
- Here the *ekklesia* seed is planted, and it grows throughout the NT

"I will build my church"

- The church is not a physical building
- The church is a spiritual building

MATTHEW 16:13 – 17:9

Scripture Reading

1. Christ is Building His Church (v. 18)

- "I" Jesus is the Builder
 - O Psalm 127:1 & Zechariah 4:6
- "My" Jesus is the Owner
 - Acts 20:28
 - O Pictures of the church always highlight the preeminence of Jesus

2. Christ is Building His Church through the Truth (vv. 13-17)

- Divine revelation (vs. human opinion)
- Divine illumination (vs. human insight)
- Apostolic teaching
 - o Acts 2:42; 20:32
 - o Ephesians 2:20

3. Christ is Building His Church through the Cross (vv. 21 ff.)

- Christology 101: His Person
- Christology 102: His Work
- The Cross had to precede the Church
 - O Peter's Temptation vv. 21-23
 - o Transfiguration Luke 9:31
 - o Rejected Cornerstone Ps 118:22

4. Christ is Building His Church through the Spirit

- Future Tense Verb: "I will build"
- Timing: Future, not Past or Present
 - Unfinished at Ascension
 - o Inaugurated at Pentecost
- Certainty: Promise, not Intention

5. Christ is Building His Church through the Church

- Peter / Keys / Binding & Loosing
- The Church = Building & Builders
 - o Pastors are Subs (1 Cor 3:9-17)
 - o EMM living stones (1 Pet 2:4-5)
 - EMM edification
 Eph 4:12, 16, 29; Rom 15:2; 1 Cor 8:1; 14:4, 12, 26; 2 Cor 13:10; 1 Thes 5:11

6. Christ is Building His Church through Evangelism (v. 18b)

- "The gates of hell shall not prevail against it."
- The power of the church is the power of the gospel (Rom 1:16)
 - o Offense, not Defense
 - o An Army, not a Monastery
