#1. Q. What is the chief end of man?

**A. Man's chief end is to glorify God and enjoy Him forever.**

**#21.1. The light of nature shows that there is a God who has lordship and sovereignty over all, that he is good and does good to all, and that he ought therefore to be feared, loved, praised, prayed to, trusted in, and served with all the heart, and with all the soul, and with all the might. But the acceptable way of worshiping the true God has been instituted by himself, and so limited by his own revealed will, that he may not be worshiped according to the imaginations or devising's of men, or the suggestions of Satan, or under any visible representation, or any other way not commanded in Holy Scripture.**
