Westminster Shorter Catechism, #79-81

79. What is the tenth commandment?

- A. The ninth commandment is, ""You shall not covet your neighbor's house; you shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or his male servant, or his female servant, or his ox, or his donkey, or anything that is your neighbor's."
- 80. What is required in the tenth commandment?
- A. The tenth commandment requires full contentment with our own condition, with a right and charitable frame of spirit toward our neighbor, and all that is his.

81. What is forbidden in the tenth commandment?

A. The tenth commandment forbids all discontentment with our own estate, envying or grieving at the good of our neighbor, and all excessive motions and affections to anything that is his.
