PRAYER: SURPRISE! | ROMANS 8:31-34 & HEBREWS 7:25

Because Jesus intercedes for us,

Context: At the end of Romans 8, the Apostle Paul asked several rhetorical questions to remind Christian believers of the absolute, unbreakable safety of God's love for His own—including amazing implications for prayer.

What does "Jesus is interceding for us" mean?
