THE GRACE TO LIVE SENSIBLY - Tit 2:12

INTRODUCTION

- 1. Unusual things can make sense if you know what lies ahead.
- 2. <u>Tit 2:11-14</u> <u>v12b</u>. Instructed by grace: put off & put on. v13 expect 2nd coming & live in anticipation. Live *sensibly* in rln to self; *righteously* in rln to others & *godly* in rln to God. Tonight live *sensibly*.

1st: A Survey of NT Sensibility

- 1. Sensibly concerns personal mindset word study...
- 2. <u>Lk 8:35</u> in his right mind = Grk term: sensible: thinking patterns; opposite of the life influenced by demonic lies: self-destructive rage [v27ff].
- 3. Paul: self-defense preach repent & Jesus' resurrection <u>A 26:24-25</u>. Festus: Paul is "maniac". Paul: words of <u>sober</u> truth.
- 4. R 12:3 realism & honesty re: self: humility
- 5. <u>2C 5:13</u> sound mind contrasted w/ beside ourselves. [Mrk 3:21 He has lost His senses (lit stand outside self)].
- 6. <u>1T 2:9-10</u> discreetly = sensible. Feminine godliness in appearance.
 - i. proper clothing (cosmetic); discreetly w/ modestly: decency.
 - ii. 3:15 how to behave fitting to worship & edification
- 7. <u>1T 2:15</u> child bearing: distinctive femininity a life of faith & love w/ self restraint (sensible).
- 8. $\underline{1\ T\ 3;2}$ elders the way a man thinks; reasonably; sound, realism
- 9. 2 T 1:7 not timid & ashamed [v8]: power, love & discipline
- 10. 1 Pt 4:7 b/c 2nd coming is near, be of sound judgment (sensible) & sober spirit or mind (temperate in 1T3:2) evidenced in one's prayer life.

2nd: The Cretan Need for Sensibility

- 1. Titus has 3 chpts (46 vss), *sensible* 6x <u>Tit 1:12-13</u>. Quote of Epimenides Cretan's notorious reputation.
 - i. Always liars: to Cretanize = to lie//cheat [Corinthianize = sexual perversity]. Locations assoc'd w/ vices.
 - ii. Evil beasts: animal-like cruelty & violence
 - iii. Lazy gluttons: indulgent, slothful, poor work ethic
 - iV. Does gospel tolerate & accommodate to culture? No v13.
- 2. Tit 1:8 saw in 1T 3:2 sound thinking exemplified in leaders.
- 3. Tit 2:2 Older men sensible
- 4. <u>Tit 2:4</u> Older women: *sensible* is verb: *encourage* admonish by example & instruction teach self-control & exert moral influence
- 5. Tit 2:5 younger women sensible. Why? Spiritual warfare
- 6. <u>Tit 2:6</u> younger men *sensible*. Titus' example <u>v7-8</u>. And <u>Tit 2:12</u>.
- 7. Summarize survey: 1) context of gospel realities; 2) in rln to self; 3) rlts to one's thots; 4) expressed in behavior
