Jacob Returns to Bethel Genesis 35:1-15

Main Point:

Come to God's house knowing that public worship is a great privilege that must be taken seriously.

1. God calls you to come to His house and worship Him.

2. Before you come to God's house, you first need to prepare yourself for worship.

3. When you arrive at God's house, you need to make sure you actually worship.

4. Worshiping God at His house is where you will receive His blessing.

Genesis 28:20-22 ²⁰ Then Jacob made a vow, saying, "If God will be with me, and keep me in this way that I am going, and give me bread to eat and clothing to put on, ²¹ "so that I come back to my father's house in peace, then the LORD shall be my God. ²² "And this stone which I have set as a pillar shall be God's house, and of all that You give me I will surely give a tenth to You." (NKJV)

Psalm 96:8 ⁸ Give to the LORD the glory *due* His name; Bring an offering, and come into His courts. (NKJV)

Psalm 100:4 ⁴ Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, *And* into His courts with praise. Be thankful to Him, *and* bless His name. (NKJV)
