- By Worshipping God Corporately and Personally


build the Church

Note: Hearing includes all modes of input: i.e. reading, hearing, singing, memorizing, etc.

The Rights to Prayer

- Reconciliation to the Father Rom5:10
- Adoption through the Son Eph1:5
- •Indwelling by the Spirit Romans 8:15

The Ingredients of Prayer

- Adoration of God (as Creator and Redeemer)
- Confession of our sin (both omission and commission)
- Thanksgiving for God's gifts (both physical and spiritual)
- •Supplication for our needs (both self and others)

The Times of Prayer

- •Focused intentional, purposeful, intensified engagement with God Psa5:3; Mat6:6-13
- •Moment-by-moment ongoing, relational, presence of God 1Thes5:17

love God - By Worshipping God...

- Worship expressing God's "worth-ship" with our hearts, minds, mouths, ears, and whole bodies
- Corporately 1Cor11:18
 - •Biblical themes of the people, a holy nation, the temple, priesthood, family, army, et al.
 - •The Lord's Day is an eschatological symbol for the Gathering of the people of God for His worship from the N/S/E/W in the presence and Spirit of God
- Personally Romans 12:1
 - •The reality of being redeemed possessions of Christ, and living the entirety of life for His glory
