What this contention reveals (2:18-19)

Goal #2: understand and embrace the resources God has give you to keep the truth about Jesus with a sincere confession even in the face of deceit (2:26)

Ensure that the fixed promises of the Gospel dwell within you (2:24-25)

Be confident that the Holy Spirit is yours as you fellowship with the true Christ(2:27)
