- 7. ¹⁰ as sorrowful yet always rejoicing,
 8. as poor yet making many rich,
 9. as having nothing yet possessing all things.

- Paul provided nine negative properties of ministry, nine positive properties, and nine paradoxes of ministry.
- Can you relate to some of the nine negative properties?
- Why are the nine positive properties of ministry so important to possess?
- What are the meanings of some of the nine paradoxes?

5. Application Question(s):

How might you better embrace this sort of authentic ministry?
