(v.18) When I say unto the wicked, Thou shalt surely die; and thou givest him not warning, nor speakest to warn the wicked from his wicked way, to save his life; the same wicked man shall die in his iniquity; but his blood will I require at thine hand.”* We are responsible to tell people about the good news of Jesus Christ and in doing so we take the blood of the lost off of our hands.

Key verse: Proverbs 11:30 “The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life; and he that winneth souls is wise.”

 - A. The Soulwinner must himself be born-again. (2 Tim. 1:12)

 - D. The Soulwinner must be serious about the business of prayer. (Jer. 33:3)

- III. The Requirements for Salvation:
 - A. Point them to the Lord Jesus. (Aralin pang Mathetes Lesson #5)
 - a. He is the sin-bearer. (Isa. 53:5-7; 10:12; Jn. 1:29; Gal. 1:4; Gal. 6:14).
 - b. He is the Risen-Saviour. (Jn. 5:24; 6:37; 10:28; 11:26; Jn. 14:19; Acts 2:36; Rom. 1:16-17; Rom. 10:9; Heb. 7:25; 1 Pet. 1:5; Jude 24).
 - B. Lead them to receive the Lord Jesus as their own Saviour.
 - a. They must forsake sin in all forms known to them [repentance]. (Isa. 55:6-7; Ezek. 33:11; Matt. 3:2; Lk. 13:3; Acts 3:19). (APM Lesson #9)
 - b. They must believe Christ in the inmost souls or with their heart (life). (Jn. 1:12; Jn. 3:16, 18, 36; Jn. 5:24; Acts 10:43; Acts 13:39; Rom. 5:1-2; Rom. 10:8-10; Gal. 2:16; Eph. 2:8-9; Titus 3:5).
 - C. Show them the meaning of Bible salvation resulting from a heart that has repented and believed the Gospel. (Jn. 3:36; Jn. 5:24; Jn. 10:27-29; Rom. 5:10; Rom. 10:9-10; Gal. 6:15). (APM Lesson #10 at Lesson #14)

 - C. The Soulwinner is growing in grace. (1 Pet. 3:15)

 - E. The Soulwinner brings joy to the converted sinner. (James 5:20)
 - F. The Soulwinner brings joy the church house. (Acts 9:31; 1 Thess. 2:19)
 - G. The Soulwinner brings joy the Heavenly Father. (Lk. 15:10 in the presence of the angels)
 - H. The Soulwinner is involved in the work of the Son, Jesus Christ. (Mk. 16:20)
 - I. The Soulwinner is endued with the power of the Holy Spirit. (Acts 1:8)
