Big View of Sin	<p>In this view we have a:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Realistic view of ourselves (sinners in deed of daily, abundant grace) • Robust view of Jesus (abounding in mercy, abundant in kindness, lavish in Grace) <p>1</p>	<p>In this view:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We view Jesus as the doorway to salvation, and now feel like we have to continually earn God's favor to keep our salvation. • We function like legalists. <p>2</p>
Small View of Sin	<p>In this view:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We view Jesus sacrifice for us very casually, and take holiness very lightly. • We function like the law of God no longer matters. <p>3</p>	<p>In this view:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We likely have never experienced a saving relationship with Jesus. • The cross is immaterial, and our view of God, Sin, Salvation, and Eternity have been shaped by our own attempts at "self-salvation" <p>4</p>
