TEXT: Ephesians 6:17 And take the helmet of salvation, and **the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God:**

2 Samuel 5:7 Nevertheless David took **the <u>strong hold</u>** of Zion: the same is the city of David. 9 So David dwelt in **the fort**...

1 Chronicles 11:7 And David dwelt in the castle; therefore they called it the city of David.

Proverbs 18:19 A brother offended is harder to be won than a strong city: and their contentions are like the bars of a castle.

Nahum 1:7 The LORD is good, a strong hold in the day of trouble; and he knoweth them that trust in him.

2 Corinthians 10:4 (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but **mighty** through God to the **pulling down of** <u>strong holds</u>;)

Psalms 149:6 Let the high praises of God be in their mouth, and a twoedged sword in their hand;

Hebrews 4:12 For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any **twoedged sword**, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit...

Jeremiah 23:29 Is not **my word** like as a fire? saith the LORD; and **like a hammer** that breaketh the rock in pieces?

"God's word rouses and strengthens the conscience and crushes within the heart everything that is evil." (Barnes)

Psalms 11:3 If the foundations be destroyed, what can the righteous do?

Proverbs 4:23 Keep thy heart with all diligence; for **out of it are the issues of life.** 24 Put away from thee a froward mouth, and perverse lips put far from thee.

Acts 5:3 But Peter said, Ananias, why hath Satan filled thine heart to lie to the Holy Ghost...

Proverbs 16:1 The **preparations of the heart** in man, and the answer of the tongue, is from the LORD. 3 Commit thy works unto the LORD, and thy thoughts shall be established.

2 Chronicles 12:14 And he did evil, because he prepared not his heart to seek the LORD.

7 But which of you, having a servant plowing or feeding cattle, will say unto him by and by, when he is come from the field, Go and sit down to meat?

8 And will not rather say unto him, Make ready wherewith I may sup, and gird thyself, and serve me, till I have eaten and drunken; and afterward thou shalt eat and drink?

9 Doth he thank that servant because he did the things that were commanded him? I trow not.

10 So likewise ye, when ye shall have done all those things which are commanded you, say, We are unprofitable servants: we have done that which was our duty to do.

Luke 18:28 Then Peter said, **Lo, we have left all**, and followed thee.

Psalms 109:18 As he clothed himself with cursing like as with his garment, so let it come into his bowels like water, and **like oil into his bones.**

Psalms 141:5 Let the righteous smite me; it shall be a kindness: and let him reprove me; it shall be an excellent oil, which shall not break my head...

2 Peter 2:14 Having eyes full of adultery, and that cannot cease from sin...

Hosea 10:12 Sow to yourselves in righteousness, reap in mercy; **break up your fallow ground**: for **it is time** to seek the LORD, till he come and rain righteousness upon you.
