God is working through our:

- I. Circumstance "Circumcision is nothing" (vs. 17-19)

 God is in our:
 - A. Ordination "as God has distributed to every man"
 - B. Origination "as the Lord has called every one"
 - C. Obedience "keeping of the commandments of God"
- II. Calling "For he that is called in the Lord" (vs. 20-22)

 God calls us to:
 - A. Peace "Let every man abide in the same calling"
 - **B.** Potential "if you may be made free, use it"
 - C. Perspective "called in the Lord... is the Lord's freeman"
- III. Communion "he that is...Christ's servant" (vs. 22-24)

 God desires a relationship that's:
 - **A.** Costly -"ye are bought with a price"
 - **B.** Confined "be not ye the servants of men"
 - C. Close "abide with God"
