## PETER'S FALL AND RISE

## I. Why Did Peter Fall? Luke 22:31-34, 54-62; Mark 14:27-31, 66-72

- I. Supper: Not \_\_\_\_\_! A. Corrects Jesus! (Lk 22:33; Mk 14:31)
  - B. Sees himself superior to the others (Mk 14:29)
- II. Gethsemane: Not \_\_\_\_\_ ! Luke 22:45-6 Not only did not pray for himself, but failed Jesus as a friend (Matt 26:36-46, esp 37-38, 40, 43, 45)

Contrast sinless Jesus Who prays 3 times for strength!

III. Arrest: **Not** \_\_\_\_\_ ! First the sword (give him that!) (Jn 18:10)

Then the flight (Mt 26:56)

Contrast Jesus Who protects them and secures their release! (Jn 18:8-9)

IV. Courtyard: Not \_\_\_\_\_ !

Refused to acknowledge that he even knew Jesus. Saying I care nothing for that man—3 different occasions!

Even calls down curses on himself if he is lying!

Terrible ordeal brought to a halt by 2 things at once:

- 1. Hears rooster crow: remembers Jesus' prophetic warning (Luke 22:60, 61b)
- Jesus is led past and looks at him with infinite sadness—and love (Luke 22:61)

The spell is broken and Peter repents with a broken heart (Luke 22:62) but vastly greater appreciation of the grace of Christ
