## WHY FOLLOW JESUS

I. JESUS IS THE SAVIOR (1:13-14)

"10 Then the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid, for behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy which will be to all people.

11 For there is born to you this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord." Luke 2:10-11

**A.** He has taken us from darkness to light (v 13).

"For our citizenship is in heaven, from which we also eagerly wait for the Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ," Philippians 3:20

**B.** He has taken us from slavery to freedom (v 14a).

"18 knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, like silver or gold, from your aimless conduct received by tradition from your fathers,

19 but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot."

I Peter 1:18-19

C. He has taken us from condemnation to forgiveness (v 14b).

"7 But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.

8 If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.

9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."

I John 1:7-9

# II. JESUS IS THE CREATOR (1:15-17)

"In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth."

Genesis 1:1

A. He is  $\overline{\text{God}}$  (v 15).

"Jesus said to him, "Have I been with you so long, and yet you have not known Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; so how can you say, 'Show us the Father'?" John 14:9

**B.** All things were made by Him (v 16a).

"All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made." John 1:3

C. All things were made for Him (v 16a).

"You are worthy, O Lord, To receive glory and honor and power; For You created all things, And by Your will they exist and were created."

Revelation 4:11

**D.** He holds all things together (v 17).

"who being the brightness of His glory and the express image of His person, and upholding all things by the word of His power,..." Hebrews 1:3a
