Reading from the Law

This passage underscores how important living and functioning according to truth, especially in the dispensation of justice, must be for the society of God's people. Note the pains prescribed to be taken to avoid falsehood, and the severity of punishment for those who perpetrate it.

Deuteronomy 19:15-21 ESV

15 "A single witness shall not suffice against a person for any crime or for any wrong in connection with any offense that he has committed. Only on the evidence of two witnesses or of three witnesses shall a charge be established. 16 If a malicious witness arises to accuse a person of wrongdoing, 17 then both parties to the dispute shall appear before the Lord, before the priests and the judges who are in office in those days. 18 The judges shall inquire diligently, and if the witness is a false witness and has accused his brother falsely, 19 then you shall do to him as he had meant to do to his brother. So you shall purge the evil from your midst. 20 And the rest shall hear and fear, and shall never again commit any such evil among you. 21 Your eye shall not pity. It shall be life for life, eye for eye, tooth for tooth, hand for hand, foot for foot.

In this adaptation of Psalm 51, among other things, we pray that God would "make our spirits right and true," reflecting David's acknowledgement that God desires "truth in the inner parts."

Assurance of Pardoning Grace

A life conformed to the truth is obligatory and now possible since we have been regenerated ("put off the 'old man' and put on the 'new man') and given new life in Christ through his work. We have already been "created after the likeness of God" and are "being renewed after...[His] image." This is the gospel.

Ephesians 4:20-25; Colossians 3:9-10 ESV

20 But that is not the way you learned Christ!—21 assuming that you have heard about him and were taught in him, as the truth is in Jesus, 22 to put off your old self, which belongs to your former manner of life and is corrupt through deceitful desires, 23 and to be renewed in the spirit of your minds, 24 and to put on the new self, created after the likeness of God in true righteousness and holiness.

²⁵ Therefore, having put away falsehood, let each one of you speak the truth with his neighbor, for we are members one of another.

Do not lie to one another, seeing that you have put off the old self with its practices 10 and have put on the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge after the image of Its creator. This song beautifully expresses that truth meets richly with mercy, righteousness, and peace, in the person of Jesus, and as we are united to Him, these virtues are established in us, and we are complete, lacking nothing as we stand before God in Him.

The cups containing wine are in the outer circles of the trays.
