The Risen Shepherd Mark 14:27–31

Jesus predicts the disciple's failure - Mark 14:27a

The disciple's failure is part of Israel's failure - Mark 14:27b

Jesus predicts Peter's denial - Mark 14:29-31

- Peter stands as leader and spokesman for the disciples. None of them expected to fall away and all of them intended to be loyal to Jesus.
- Peter would fail worse than the others. He would completely and absolutely deny Him three times, even that very night!
- Peter spoke from the greatest strength a human heart could muster.

Peter denies Jesus - Mark 14:66-72

 Peter was overwhelmed with the thought of how terrible his denial was. He wept uncontrollably because he was repentant - Psalm 51:3–4 For I acknowledge my transgressions, And my sin is always before me. Against You, You only, have I sinned, And done this evil in Your sight—

Jesus is crucified - Mark 15

- The cross is the glorious qualification for Jesus the King of the Jews v. 26
- Jesus was crucified as a criminal, law-breaker, and sinner against God v. 27–28

Jesus is raised from the dead - Mark 16:1-8

- The empty tomb is proof of the resurrection.
- Jesus fulfilled the promise He made to rise from the dead Mark 14:27–28

Jesus is the Good Shepherd who gives His life for the sheep - Zechariah 13:7

- God's Shepherd is the One who will love and lead in God's paths -
- He will be a Man and will identify Himself with the sheep.
- He will be God's Companion (friend, equal, kin) sharing His deity.
- The LORD God will strike Him with the sword, thus executing His wrath and justice upon Him. This is a great prophecy of Christ's sacrifice.
- The Lord promised to safeguard the little ones of the flock.

Peter is restored at Galilee - John 21:1-19

Jesus is the Risen Shepherd who is gathering His flock - 1 Peter 2:25 For you were like sheep going astray, but have now returned to the Shepherd and Overseer of your souls.

You must recognize yourself as a scattered sheep coming to the Shepherd who was struck for your sin and was raised to give you eternal life!

Hebrews 13:20–21 Now may the God of peace who brought up our Lord Jesus from the dead, that great Shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, make you complete in every good work to do His will, working in you what is well pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory forever and ever. Amen.


