

## "AS A BELIEVER IN CHRIST, IF YOU CAN'T LOSE YOUR SALVATION, WHAT CAN YOU LOSE?" Pt.6

### I. The QUESTION:

\* Though the one who has genuinely been saved by God's grace through placing his complete trust in the person and work of Jesus Christ can't lose his salvation, what can he lose?

### II. The ANSWER:

If you've trusted in Christ alone, your salvation is eternal and secure but you can lose...

\* Fixed principle:
