In the prayer of Hebrews, he reminds the people that Jesus is not dead, He is the great shepherd who took their place, died for them, and is now actively leading and loving them.

10

Jesus is not only the Shepherd who died for you, he is the Shepherd that lives for you. When we think of the resurrection, we should not just look back to an historical event, but to the fact that Jesus is alive and active in the welfare of His sheep.

11

The author emphasizes the resurrection of Christ to remind people that through Jesus Christ life, death, and resurrection, they are part of the eternal covenant.

12

The problem with the Old Covenant was the people who were always breaking the covenant, the tremendous difference in the New Covenant is that it cannot be broken.

13

Hebrews 9:15

"Therefore he is the mediator of a new covenant, so that those who are called may receive the promised eternal inheritance, since a death has occurred that redeems them from the transgressions committed under the first covenant."

All members of this covenant are forgiven and have inherit eternal life.

Matthew 26:26-29

Those who are in the New Covenant are sealed with the blood of Christ. They have forgiveness of sins and will be with Christ in heaven.

Sermon: Hebrews 13:20-24

1. Far from being reserved for a one-day celebration, the resurrection of Christ permeated the Christian life.

A. Was the resurrection important to the proclamation of the gospel? See Acts 2:22-24, Acts 10:34-43, Romans 1:1-4, and 1 Cor. 15:3-5.

B. With that in mind, when you have heard the gospel shared, is the resurrection included? _____ Should it be included when you share the gospel? _____ Why do you suppose that this key component is sometimes left out?

2. The fact that Christ rose from the dead and ascended into heaven is of utmost importance to the preaching and teaching of the New Testament.

A. What wonderful truth for Christians is connected to the Christ's resurrection in these passages? See Acts 4:1-2, 1 Corinthians 15:12-20, Phil. 1:23

3. The Jews hated the Christian teaching that Christ had risen from the dead. Why did they hate this teaching, and what did it mean for them. See Acts 7:51-60.

4. What assurance is to be found in Hebrews 10:11-18 for believers that is based upon Christ's death and resurrection?

5. What lesson can be applied to the Christian life in Hebrews 12:1-3 that is tied to the suffering, death, and resurrection of Christ?

6. How is prayer a constant reminder to the Christian that Jesus has risen from the dead?
